

Science Fun for Your Family

Magnets

You Need

1 bar magnet, or a horseshoe magnet

a small compass

1 sewing needle


1 plastic bucket

1 Styrofoam™ coffee cup

1 box of objects, such as a cork, a rubber stopper, a steel washer, a paper clip, a penny, a glass 'marble', a piece of paper, a thumb tack, a staple, a small finishing nail, an aluminum roofing nail, and an assortment of Canadian coins: pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters, loonies, two dollar coins.

Try This!

- 1. Test a large variety of objects to see which ones are attracted to your magnet. What metal or metals are in the objects that are attracted to your magnet?
- 2. Test a variety of Canadian coins to see which ones are attracted to a magnet. Be sure to use at least one nickel with a date prior to 1982, and another nickel with a date after 1982. Before 1982, nickels were really made of nickel! From 1982 until 2000, they were made of an alloy that is mostly copper. 'Nickels' made after 2001 are magnetic again! They contain iron, which is magnetic.
- 3. Set a compass down on a table. Make sure there are no magnetic objects around it (other than planet Earth). Locate magnetic north by watching which way the north end of the compass points.






Figure 1 Figure 2


4. Place a bar magnet flat on your table. Place the compass at each of the locations in **Figure 1**. Make a copy of this diagram and draw in the directions of the compass needle for each location.

The north pole of your compass will be attracted to the south pole of the bar magnet, and repelled by the north pole of your magnet. If this seems contrary to what you observed with planet Earth, it is because what we call Earth's 'north magnetic pole' is actually a south magnetic pole! (The direction of Earth's magnetic field shifts over time. In a few thousand years, the north end of Earth may become a true north magnetic pole again.)

- 5. You can make your own compass needle. Stroke a sewing needle with a bar magnet several times.
- 6. Make a raft out of the bottom of a Styrofoam[™] coffee cup, and poke the needle through the walls of the 'raft'. See **Figure 2**.
- 7. Set the raft down on the water in a plastic bucket, and watch it float around until the magnetized needle lines up with earth's magnetic field.


Be a Tacks Collector!

Compare the strengths of a variety of permanent magnets, by dipping them into a pile of thumb tacks and counting how many tacks you can collect with each magnet.

Explanation of "Finger Magnetism" (Cover Photo): The demonstrator (some really old guy) is actually using a type of **Cartesian diver**. When he asks **Hayden** to move his finger down the side of the bottle, the demonstrator simultaneously squeezes the plastic pop bottle. The test tube inside the bottle moves downward, seemingly following the youngster's finger. A Cartesian diver illustrates **Pascal's Law**: Pressure applied anywhere in an enclosed fluid is transmitted everywhere within the fluid. Increased pressure compresses the trapped air inside the test tube and water flows into the test tube, making it heavy enough to sink to the bottom of the bottle of water. (Note: This was one of the late **Tik Liem's** many priceless demonstrations.)




