

Gary Williams, co-captain of the 1967 Maryland basketball team, landed his first head coaching job at the age of twenty-four, taking his team to victory at the New Jersey State Championship in 1970. Williams soon took positions at American University, Boston College, and Ohio State before returning to Maryland where in the spring of 2002, he led the Terrapins to capture the program's first ever NCAA national championship in men's basketball. Williams won more than 600 games in his career and had the most wins against number one ranked teams. In 2014, he was inducted into both the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame.



CELEBRITY LECTURER VERNE LUNDQUIST

With more than 50 years in broadcasting, Verne Lundquist continues as CBS Sports' beloved sportscaster, providing play-by-play commentary for NCAA football and basketball, NCAA Tournaments, and the PGA Championships. He was honored with a Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences in 2016. He lives in Steamboat Springs, Colorado, with his wife, Nancy. Recently, the Lundquists were named the Yampa Valley Community Foundation's "Philanthropist of the Year" in Steamboat Springs.
