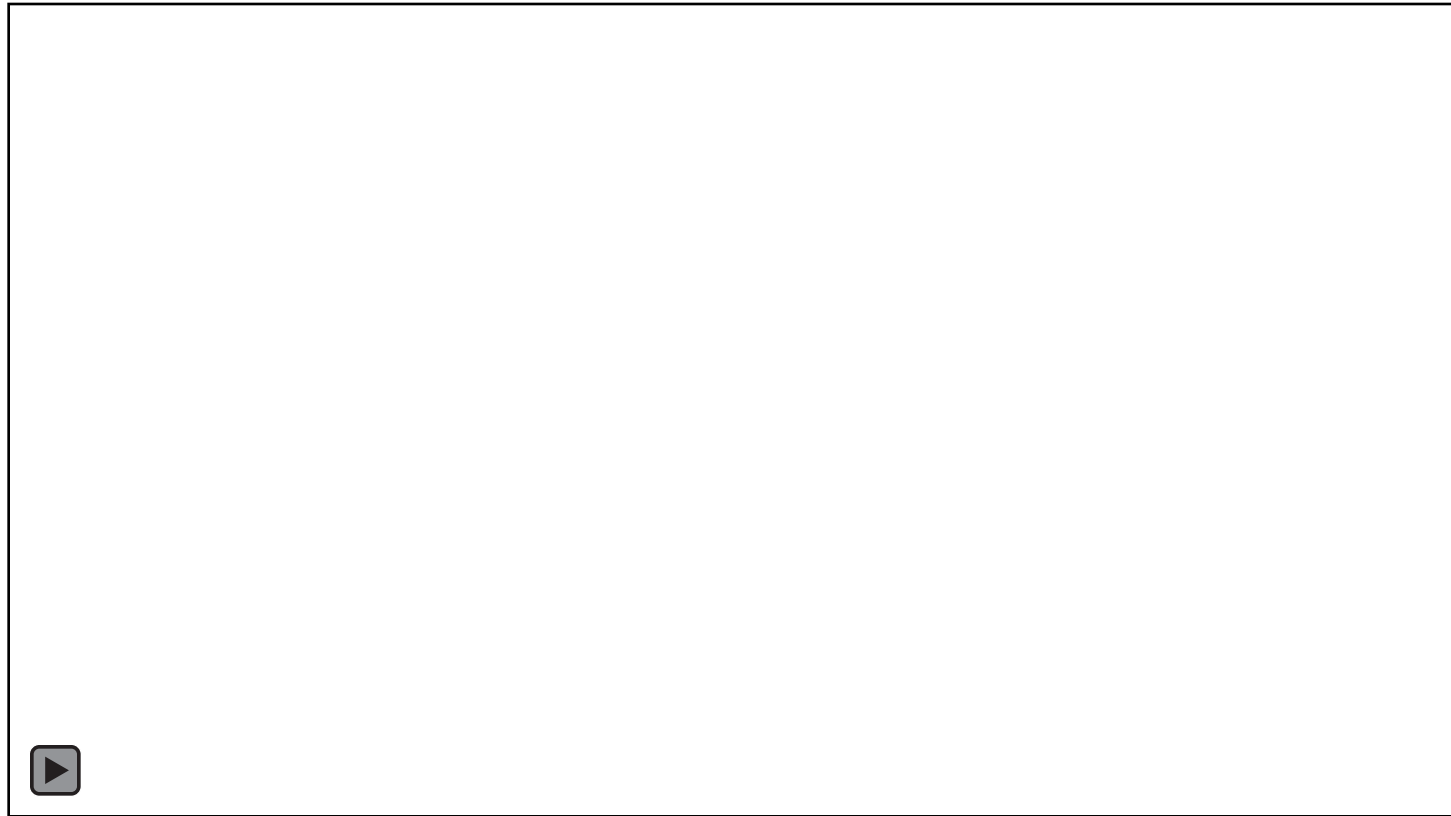

Grade Point Average = GPA

- ▶ GPA is not the average of grades.
- ▶ It is the average of quality points which are based on grades and course rigor (difficulty).
- ▶ Honors = Grade + .5 Quality Points.
- ▶ AP/IB = Grade + 1 Quality Point.
- ▶ GPA speaks of both effort and rigor.
- ▶ AP stands for Advanced Placement courses which are taught to the college level of rigor.

- ▶ Q1 means Quarter 1, 2, 3, 4
- ▶ S1 means Semester 1, 2
- ▶ E1 means Exam 1, 2
- ▶ F1 means Final Grade for the Course
- ▶ Grade Point Average (GPA) is the average of quality points, not grades.
- ▶ YTD ABS is Year To Date Absences

Calculating Your GPA

- ▶ Write the number of quality points beside each grade on the report card and add.
- ▶ If the class is “Honors” add .5 to the number.
- ▶ If the class is AP/IB add 1 point to the number.

Calculating Grade Point Average

- ▶ Divide the sum by 4.
- ▶ If these were final grades, you would have the GPA.
- ▶ GPA is not on the report card. It is shown on the transcript.

Weighted or Unweighted

- ▶ Weighted GPA means the average includes the “bonus” points for taking Honors, Advanced Placement, or IB classes
- ▶ Unweighted GPA does not include the “bonus” quality points. It is the average of the grade points only.
- ▶ Both are included on the transcript which is sent per request for college and scholarship applications.

Transcript shows: Final Grade and Credit GPA is Automatically Calculated

“U” counts toward UNC Minimum Course Requirements

“EU” Course is excluded from GPA

“PU” Course is in Progress
