






# Refugee Boy Benjamin Zephaniah

As a ghost, watching his family trying to cope with his death, Jerome begins to notice other ghost boys.








## <u>Skin Deep</u> Tony Bradman




### <u>Pigeon English</u> Steven Kelman

#### <u>Ghost</u> <u>Jason Reynolds</u>




What's worse than hiding a secret? Liccle Bit's about to find out...







- The Ku Klux Klan attacked and lynched black people.
- Black people were not allowed to use white public facilities such as schools and parks. This was called 'segregation'.
- The Fourteenth Amendment to the US Constitution granted
