Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

"Behold, a righteous king will reign, and princes will rule with justice." The only-begotten Word of God, together with God the Father, has always been king of the universe, and to him all creatures, visible and invisible, are subject.

People on earth, having been caught in the snares of sin, were persuaded by the devil to reject his sovereignty and to despise his royal power, but the judge and dispenser of all justice brought them back under his own dominion.

All his ways are straight, says scripture, and by the ways of Christ we mean the divine precepts laid down in the gospel. By observing them we make progress in every virtue, do honor to ourselves by the moral beauty of our lives, and attain the heavenly reward to which we have been called.

These are straight, not winding ways: they are direct and easily followed. As it is written, "The way of the upright is straight; the road of the just is made smooth."

Its many decrees make the law a rugged way and its difficulty intolerable, but the way of gospel commands is smooth, without any roughness or steep ascents.

The ways of Christ are straight, then, and as for the holy city, which is the Church, he himself was its builder and he makes it his own dwelling. In other words, he makes the saints his dwelling: sharing as we do in the Holy Spirit, we have Christ within us and have become temples of the living God.

Christ is both the founder of the Church and its foundation, and upon this foundation we, like precious stones, are built into a holy temple to become, through the Spirit, a dwelling place for God.

Since it has in Christ such a firm foundation, the Church can never be shaken. Scripture says: "I am laying the foundation stone of Zion, the cornerstone, chosen and precious. No one who believes in him will ever be put to shame."

from bondage. He saved us from the power of Satan and of sin, freed us, and subjected us to his own rule, but not by paying a ransom or by bribes.

As one of his disciples wrote, "We have been freed from the futile ways handed down to us by our ancestors, not by anything perishable like silver and gold, but by the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without mark or blemish."

He gave his own blood for us, so that we no longer belong to ourselves, but to him who bought us and saved us. Those therefore who turn aside from the noble rule of the true faith are justly accused by all the saints of denying the Lord who redeemed them.

He needs the cards to download his favorite music and vidoes to boost his confidence on his next phase of surgery and fight over cancer which he's going to undergo today but i can't do this now. God Bless" [sic]

To avoid parishioner's falling for this ploy, please note that Father would NEVER email a request such as this! If you should get such email, please ignore all such requests or check with the parish office.

Words on the Word

April 14, 2019 — Crucify Him!

It's not uncommon to hear the term "crucifixion" used metaphorically to describe a person taking a figurative beating. In the news recently, for example, we heard of a group of priests in Poland who burned books they deemed to be dealing with witchcraft. Among the books were several from a children's series that chronicles the elementary school years of a group of young witches and wizards. There was, as one might expect, worldwide criticism of the Polish priests that — whether you agree or disagree with their position — could be likened to a figurative crucifixion. Closer to home, when the Detroit Red Wings announced they were renewing the contract of their embattled coach for another two years, thousands of people flooded the team's social media accounts with harsh denunciation of the move, again subjecting the key players in the story — coach, team management, ownership — to a figurative crucifixion. To be clear, neither of those examples — and nothing we might possibly conceive of, frankly — are anything remotely close in their horror, or in their profound impact, to the actual crucifixion, which we commemorate today, and on which we'll reflect this week.

But it's worth keeping in mind that Jesus offered his suffering and death precisely in atonement for the sins of each and every one of us. And one of those sins is the harsh, non-charitable, downright mean treatment of our brothers and sisters. We may disagree with things they do or say, some of it more important than others, but we should see in them the face of Christ, and perhaps be gentler in our approach. "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit," we hear in today's passion account from St. Luke, "and when he had said this he breathed his last." Such a profound sacrifice. May we never take it for granted when interacting with our brothers and sisters.



Bring & Ring the Bells on Holy Thursday!

Do you have bells in your home? If so, dust them off and bring them to church on April 18th for the Holy Thursday Mass. During this Mass, right at the end of the *Gloria*, you will be invited to join us in ringing the bells. Bring as many bells as you have and share with another parishioner at the Mass. From the end of the of the *Gloria* at the Holy Thursday Mass until the beginning of the *Gloria* at the Easter Vigil all bells in the church remain silent in remembrance of Christ's death.

In Matthew D. Herrera's article titled "Sanctus Bells, Their History and Use in the Catholic Church," we learn that early in church history bells have been ringing to respond to Psalm 98:4 where we, God's faithful, are encouraged to create a joyful noise to the Lord. The use of bells is mentioned four times in the Old Testament of the Bible. (2)

Herrera further explains that in Exodus 28:33-35 and 39:25-26 and Ecclesiasticus (Sirach) 45:9 the bells were likely included as part of high-priest Aaron's vestments for two reasons. First, they created a joyful noise to God, which is something man should undertake as described in Psalm 98:4. Secondly, bells were long thought to possess apotropaic powers, or the power to ward off evil spirits. The bells were seen as tools to be used to avert dangers to Aaron before he entered the Holiest of Holies. Furthermore, in Zechariah 14:20, the bells were used to express adoration to God. Throughout the centuries of church history, bells were also used to summon the monks to worship, then to call the faithful to Mass and to ring out loud for those not able to attend the Mass that something divine and miraculous was taking place, giving them an opportunity for private adoration.
