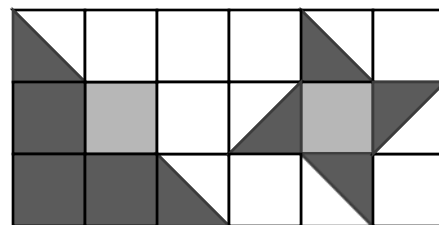


# A Flower Bouquet

### Flower bud block

#### Ruler Cutting

##### Light fabrics

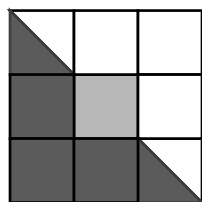
- Cut 1 square 3" x 3"
- Cut 3 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Dark fabrics

- Cut 1 square 3" x 3"
- Cut 3 squares 2.5" x 2.5"



### Friendship star block

#### Ruler Cutting

##### Light fabrics

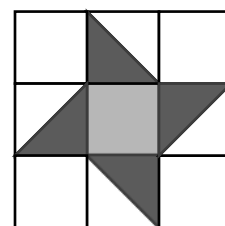
- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3"
- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Dark Fabric

- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3"



### Gemini Die Cutting

##### Light fabrics

- Cut 2 triangles 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 3 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Dark fabrics

- Cut 2 triangles 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 3 squares 2.5" x 2.5"

**TIP:**  
**USE scraps**  
**for squares**

### Gemini Die Cutting

##### Light fabrics

- Cut 4 squares 2.5" x 2.5"
- Cut 4 triangles 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Medium fabrics

- Cut 1 square 2.5" x 2.5"

##### Dark Fabric

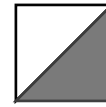
- Cut 4 triangles 2.5" x 2.5"

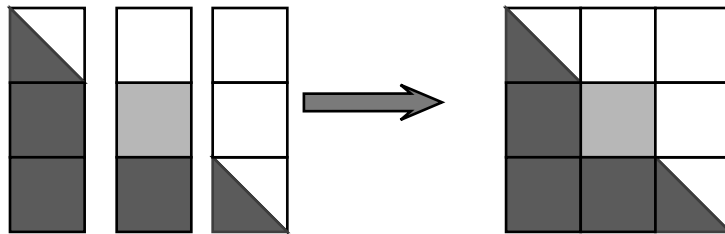
# A Flower Bouquet

## Directions Flower Bud

1) Using the 3" light and 3" dark fabric squares make HSTs  
trim to 2.5" square  
Make 2 units

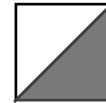


2) Following the diagram Sew the hst units, 3 of the 2.5" light squares, 3 of the 2.5" dark square and the medium square together  
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

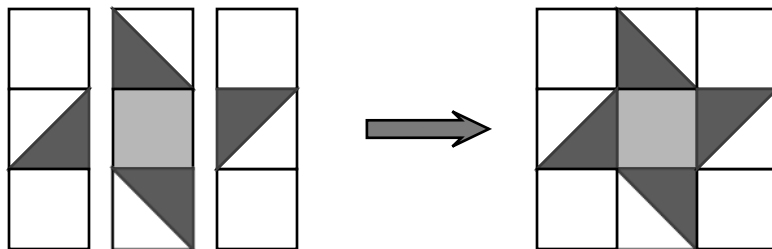


## Directions Friendship Star

1) Using the 3" light and 3" dark fabric squares make HSTs  
trim to 2.5" square  
Make 4 units



3) Following the diagram Sew the 2.5" light squares, medium square, and HST together  
Measures 6.5" x 6.5"
