REGULAR BOARD MEETING
Thursday, January 16, 2014---6:40 to 9:40pm

LA City Fire Station #89 Community Room 7063 Laurel Canyon Blvd., North Hollywood, CA 91615

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Zeke Barragan at 7:00pm. since President Moscoso had to come later to the meeting. The Vice President led us in the Pledge of Allegiance and welcomed everyone that was present.

There were some 23 persons attending this meeting.

The Secretary called the roll of board members. The nine members present were: Zeke Barragan, Jeffrey Garner, Sarah Ramsawack, Marlene Cardozo, Florence Dorick, Judy Harris, Chuck Loring, Ben Moore, and Tina Sunderland. A quorum was declared.

Those absent were Ernie Moscoso (who is expected about 8:30pm). John Basteghian was excused, Ruben Borges was excused, Ronald Cross was excused, and Inez T. Morin was excused. Edan Harris will arrive soon.

Item #4 on the Agenda--Approval of the Minutes

Ben Moore moved to accept the Minutes for November 21, 2013, as written, and the second was by Chuck Loring. The vote was 9-yes, 0-no, and 0-abstain.

Ben Moore moved to accept the Minutes for the Special Meeting on December 10, 2013, as written, and the second was by Chuck Loring. The vote was 9-yes, 0-no, and 0-abstain.

The Vice President declared an exception with the Brown Act since the Board Member Comments was not listed on the agenda. Florence Dorick spoke about the Hope of the Valley. Sarah Ramsawack spoke about the status of Neighborhood Council banners that are displayed in our council area, and the cost that the Council has paid for the display of the two designs that the Council chose. The cost exceeded \$13,000. And Florence Dorick stated that the vendor told her that the loss of ten (10) banners is a good record for banners to survive the damage of strong winds. It was noted that an increase in the number of banners on major traffic ways can improve the statement of NC presence.

7:10pm Alisa Smith, our INDEPENDENT ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR arrives.

Item #6 on the Agenda-Stakeholder Comments on Non-agenda Items
Bob Peppermuller from Mid-town North Hollywood Neighborhood Council spoke
about the need for Sidewalk Repairs. The estimated cost for all the City is over
\$10,000,000. And he said the 50/50 plan where both property owners partner
with the City to pay the cost is expected to be coming back.

Gary Aggas, President of the Sun Valley Area Neighborhood Council invited our Council to swap volunteer poll workers for our two Councils.¹ The Elections for Sun Valley will be in the auditorium of PolyTech High School on Saturday, March 8, 2014, from 11am to 3pm. Our Election will be on Thursday, March 20, 2014, at the Fire Station from 4pm to 8pm.

Stakeholder, Silvio Delgado, Jr., spoke about the problem on Lankershim Boulevard. His business location is the Golden Valley Insurance at 7542 Lankershim Blvd., and between the South wall of his building and the next building that is South of him, is a passage way about three feet wide. This passage way is between the street on Lankershim and the alleyway and the large parking lot behind all the businesses in that block. The passage way can connect pedestrians between the parking and the street. Since there are no windows or doors on either wall of the two buildings, the walls are repeatedly hit with graffiti and during nocturnal hours the darkness can conceal misbehaviors of

conduct. Mr. Delgado has spoken to the property owner, and to all of the vendors on Lankershim and they are asking to install 12-foot high fences at both ends of the passage to prevent graffiti, debris, and drug sales. Lorraine Diaz, deputy for Paul Krekorian's office for City Council District #2 will check in with this problem and the proposed solution. Further information should be discussed with the LAPD and the Fire Department.²

Stakeholder Jack Lindblad is seeking signatures on his petition to become a member of the State Senate. He says he is currently on the board of the Arleta Neighborhood Council.

Stakeholder Karl Kunak said that the traffic stripes at the intersection of Webb Avenue and Lankershim Boulevard can create an accident. He also said that the dust problem is worsening by LA By-Products, a large acreage North of 11501 Strathern Street, and including location on the East at 8301 Tujunga Avenue. Mr. Kunak also spoke about the matter of Council boundaries is under discussion with Melvin Canas of DONE.

7:35pm Brandon Pender, our Neighborhood Council Budget Advocate arrives.

Item #5 on the Agenda-Comments by Government Representatives Franklin Ochoa, deputy for Raul Bocanegra spoke briefly.

Lorraine Diaz, deputy for Paul Krekorian, spoke about upcoming events and she handed out reusable free shopping bags as the law became effective on January 1, 2014, to cease using the disposable plastic bags at large stores. For the smaller stores the date to cease the use of plastic bags is July 1, 2014.

Lorraine Diaz said that the colder weather is a larger problem for the homeless, and they are trying to connect the homeless with services and I.D.cards.

She spoke about the \$10,000 grant per each of the eight (8) Neighborhood Councils in the CD#2 for area beautification from Paul Krekorian.

Lorraine Diaz reported on the status for the intersection of Camellia and Saticoy that was the great concern of Stakeholder Richard Valdez. She said the 90-day traffic study is in progress and may be completed by mid-March 2014. Based on

the result of the study, the next step concerns Funding. With recent new federal grants, the project may take a minimum of three years to complete.

Officer Gabriel Ahedo, our SLO³ from the North Hollywood Police Division told us about the great number of thefts of personal property from motor vehicles. He also gave us more encouraging statistics on reduced numbers of crimes.

Officer Ahedo spoke about a recent kidnapping attempt of a 14-year old girl near Kittridge and Laurel Canyon. The girl escaped, and the suspect has been arrested.

Officer Ahedo and Chuck Loring expressed concern about the problem with the California Assembly Bill AB109⁴ where a criminal can be on parole based on the last crime committed and not related to previous and possibly more serious crimes, and how the law can reduce the very high population of incarcerated persons in the State of California⁵ and potentially increase crimes committed.

Our Neighborhood Council Budget Advocate, Brandon Pender spoke about the progress of the Budget Advocates in the study of the current City Budget, and how they organize the study to propose money saving recommendations in the next White Paper for the 2014-2015 budget. The next budget begins on July 1, 2014. Pender also said that the Advocates tackled a problem with the level of participation of the Budget Advocates, by changing the previous election of two Budget Advocates and one Alternative, to have a new total of three Budget Advocates at the next Election.

Item #7 on the Agenda-The Elections for March 20, 2014

Alisa Smith, the Independent Elections Administration (IEA) for Region 4 (which includes our NC) spoke about preparing for the elections.

Zeke Barragan, our NC Vice President, and the Co-Chair of the Elections Committee, told us to be sure that the seven board members who will be on the Ballot must file a Candidate Application online before midnight on February 3, 2014, or by faxing a hard copy to the City Clerk before 5pm on February 3, 2014.

and he provided a current expense record for the Elections.6

Zeke Barragan stressed the importance of submitting their application several days in advance and to not wait for the February 3rd deadline.⁷

Item #9 on the Agenda-MLK Cleanup Event on January 20, 2014

In the campaign for "Cleaner North Hollywood" the two co-chairs, Marlene Cardozo, and Jeffrey Garner have worked to organize a successful and impressive Event that can improve the appearance of our Neighborhood Council.8

We were instructed that board members who were to work on the event should arrive by 8:30am. The program and activity is from 9am to 1pm at assigned locations on the Council streets and on the West side of Whitsett, the slope beside the Department of Transportation, with various elected officials to attend.

Team Leaders for the cleanup will include Edan Harris, Judy Harris, Ben Moore, Tina Sunderland, and others. The teams will start leaving the Fire Station for their assigned areas at 9am.

At 8:30pm, President Moscoso arrives

Item #8 on the Agenda- Rachel Torres and the Raise LA Campaign

Rachel Torres works for the LA Alliance for a New Economy, and the Raise LA Campaign strives to achieve a living wage for all the service workers in the major hotels with over 100 rooms in the City that do not have a workers union to help them obtain benefits and salary increases. Currently those workers also need to have available five paid days of sick leave. She requests a letter of support in their efforts but no name or address was provided.

This item is tabled to the meeting on February 20, 2014.

Back to Item #5 on the Agenda-Government Representatives

Senior Lead Officer, Esther Vasquez, reported about the Crime Statistics in our area North of Saticoy Street (which separates the Foothill Police Division from the North Hollywood Police Division.)

Officer Vasquez encouraged everyone to attend the Town Hall Meeting on Public Safety, on Wednesday, January 29, 2014 from 6pm to 8pm at the Van Nuys City Hall, located at 14410 Sylvan Street, in Van Nuys. The special guest speaker will be Deputy Chief Jorge A. Villegas from Operation of the Valley Police Bureau. Other Speakers will include CouncilMember Nury Martinez, and several Neighborhood Council leaders. This is a great opportunity for everyone interested in Public Safety.

Caesar Huerta, the deputy for Nury Martinez from CD#6 spoke about Tree People having a FREE FRUIT TREE giveaway on March 1, 2014, at Roger Jessup Park, at 12467 Osborne Street, in Pacoima, and one tree per family that has registered to attend the event.¹⁰ The application below for FREE fruit trees is accepted on a first served basis.

Caesar Huerta also spoke about other upcoming events such as the LA Land Trust which hopes to convert vacant Public Open Land into gardens and parks. The Land Trust is having a Community Forum in the Pacoima Neighborhood City Hall at 13520 Van Nuys Blvd., in Pacoima, on Wednesday, January 29th, 2014.¹¹

Item #10 on the Agenda-Committee Reports

Ben Moore, Chair of the Communications Committee, reported that the next meeting would be on Tuesday, January 28, 2014, at 6:30pm at the Fire Station.¹²

Zeke Barragan, Chair of the City Services Committee said that their next meeting will be on Tuesday, January 28, 2014, and will begin at 6:00pm.¹³

Sarah Ramsawack, Chair of the Land Use Committee reported that our meeting of October 24, 2013, was productive in researching some of our properties, and that since Thanksgiving fell on the fourth Thursday, we did not have a meeting in November. We went to the first Thursday on December 5, 2013, for an inspiring

training session with Challis MacPherson who discussed what we can do with 7054 Laurel Canyon Blvd., and the next meeting will be on Thursday, January 23, 2014, at the Fire Station.

Jeffrey Garner, the NC liaison with the Los Angeles Dept. of Water and Power, reported that their CEO Ron NIchols has said that his final day with the DWP will be January 31, 2014.¹⁴

Sarah Ramsawack reported on the issues discussed at the VANC meeting of January 9, 2014, which was attended by Sarah Ramsawack and Florence Dorick.

Aida Valencia from the BSS explained that the second NC Blitz for pavement repairs is coming and we can include alley ways, sidewalk repairs, and areas of long-standing stagnant waters, and she is asking for each NC to provide a maximum of 15-locations where repairs are needed inside the boundaries of our Neighborhood Council. She said that the deadline for submitting the list is on Thursday, January 23, 2014.¹⁵&¹⁶

The guest speaker at the VANC meeting was the newly elected City Attorney, Mike Feuer. He explained the Proposition D which had the original intention to aid persons suffering great pain, such as cancer, that were not responsive to other stronger analgesics. Mike Feuer said that after December 18, 2013, that new dispensaries will be unlawful. He is asking NCs to report any suspected marijuana dispensaries that are 1,000 feet or less, from a school of any kind to be reported to the LAPD for the underlying investigation.

The City Attorney also gave importance to the Motion by Nury Martinez about the pro-longed harrassment some members suffer in the Neighborhood Council. He opened up the discussion to the full VANC attendance and we were all surprised at how these community volunteers are being mistreated with adult bullying incidents. He gave serious consideration to the matter, and stressed that we file a COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT on the City Council File #11-1017-S1. The CIS will become a permanent City Council record of every file to which we do submit a CIS.¹⁷ Some of the stories that we shared around the table ranged from disrespect by one member to another to out-right angry threat of physical assault against the group leader. The matter of the discussion came from the mass resignation that occurred at the North Hills West Neighborhood Council where after long and repeated abuses five board members and a long time working Stakeholder has requested that investigations be conducted about the allegations of discrimination and harassment. In their letter of resignation the wording is "due to allegations of sexism and unprofessional behavior".¹⁸

Mike Feuer invites every NC or member to call his assistant Carla Cortez at #213-978-8100 if abusive behaviors become repeated and unacceptable.

Grayce Liu, the DONE General Manager is struggling to resolve the matter of the Neighborhood Councils using checking accounts. She also strongly encourages the development of CIS reports and and for each NC to submit them. She is looking for 3-4 CIS statements from each Neighborhood Council.

Stephen Box, said the deadline for filing Candidate applications for Region #4 is Monday, February 3, 2014. If you file by phone or by mail the **deadline is 5pm.** Filing online has a deadline of midnight.

The VANC eleventh year anniversary Mixer will be on April 10, 2014 at Carla's Cafe and we are requesting that this item be on the February agenda for discussion and to support the event for up to \$150.

Item #11 on the Agenda-Treasurer's Report

Jeffrey Garner provided two itemized statements of expenses.¹⁹ One report was for November 2013 showing a total spent of \$993.09. The other report was for December 2013 showing a total spent of \$1,752.75. Some of the expenses were for Outreach; some for cleanup on November 2, 2013, staged on Lankershim and Hart; some for the shirts for MLK Day of Service, and several items under the Operations Category, including having three keys to access the Neighborhood Council P.O. Box at the Post Office at 7063 Laurel Canyon Blvd., in North Hollywood. The keys were provided to the President, Ernie Moscoso, to the Treasurer, Jeffrey Garner, and to the Secretary, Sarah Ramsawack.²⁰

Zeke Barragan moved to accept the Treasurer's Report for November 2013, and the second was by Judy Harris. The vote was 10-yes, 0-no, 0-abstain, and Edan Harris was out of the room.

Zeke Barragan moved to accept the Treasurer's Report for December 2013, and the second was by Florence Dorick. The vote was 11-yes, 0-no, and 0-abstains.

The treasurer did report that the \$1,000 was received by the Korenstein School for the uniforms for the disadvantaged students at the school. He also indicated that the Valley Plaza Library did receive the \$4,000 we had provided for new reading chairs. The total balance available to the NC is estimated as \$16,000.

Item #12 on the Agenda-Website Maintenance

Ben Moore has received the renewal statement for the Website Maintenance Agreement for \$2,400 for the year from Wendy Moore. This agreement covers 24.5 hours of maintenance per year. Zeke Barragan moved to accept the agreement for \$2,400 and the second was by Florence Dorick. The vote was 11-yes, 0-no, no-abstains.

Item #13 on the Agenda-Discuss the Nury Martinez motion #11-1017-S1

There was a brief review of the motion and its meaning that became a focus of harassment and unprofessional behavior in the NC system due to the resignation of five board members and one long-time worker-Stakeholder at the North Hills West Neighborhood Council . Ben Moore said that, he, as a City Employee as taken the mandated training that promotes an environment and culture of

respect, but he does not at this time believe that NC volunteers need to be mandated to the training on this matter.

Chuck Loring believes there will be a need or enforcing these behaviors of respect and he feels like those who resigned needed to work more in the system rather than resigning enmasse.

Both speakers expressed the need for DONE to make more effective responses (to this need that seems to be a growing problem in the NC system.)

Discussion on this matter is being tabled for the meeting of February 20, 2014, and a possible CIS.

Item #16 on the Agenda-East Valley Baseball Equipment

Frank Miceli, director/coach of the East Valley Baseball came with his paperwork for his request for funding for equipment for he East Valley Baseball. The agenda description was or a National Baseball Tournament, but as our treasurer has said, we can support with funding for equipment, but not for traveling for a Tournament.

Sarah Ramsawack made the Motion to support the East Valley Baseball with equipment up to \$2,500 for this organization that helps a good percentage of youth from our Neighborhood Council, and the second was by Florence Dorick. After more questions and discussion the motion passed with a vote of 11-yes, 0-no, and 0-abstains.

Item #17 on the Agenda-and Ad Hoc committee to start plans for Retreat
The president asked for those who were interested to raise their hands. Those
who wanted to work on the plans were Judy Harris, Florence Dorick, and Sarah
Ramsawack.

Items #15, #18, and #19 were tabled to the next meeting on February 20, 2014 due to lack of time to discuss on January 16, 2014.

At 10:05pm the motion to adjourn was unanimous.


