What To Do

When A Death Occurs

When a death occurs, coping is easier if you know what to do next. This checklist might be helpful.

1. Contact Executive Director Allison Newfeld at the Synagogue at 402-492-8550 to assist you in making arrangements. If you have had no prior planned agreement, Beth El will help guide you with arrangements.,
2. Call the Jewish Funeral Home at 402-556-9392 to arrange for proper care of the deceased and Tahara. Preferred Funeral Homes are John A. Gentleman Mortuaries and Heafey Hoffmann Dworak Cutler Mortuaries.
3. **The time and place of the service will be coordinated with Rabbi Abraham during your consultation.** Decide whether the service will take place at the Chapel of the cemetery or graveside. Contact immediate family, close friends and employer or business colleagues. Select pallbearers.
4. Write a Memoriam, “Barukh Dayan Haemet”. Information to include: date and time of passing, surviving immediate family members, Funeral plans, Shiva information, and suggest memorial gifts be given in lieu of flowers being sent.
5. Choose an appropriate memorial to which gifts may be made. You may establish a named endowment fund at the Synagogue in memory of the departed or designate an existing Beth El fund for contributions. If you do not have a designated fund, we suggest contributions be made to the Cemetery Fund.

The Rabbi and Executive Director will provide helpful resources to guide you with other practical concerns.

The yahrzeit candle should burn from sunset to sunset, on the anniversary of the day of death according to the Hebrew calendar, starting on the evening preceding the day. A selection from Psalms or other passages found elsewhere in this book may be read. There is no special prayer or benediction to be recited. It is appropriate to mediate briefly, silently or aloud. Some suggested reflections follow.

 I now recall my dear _____ who has gone to his/her eternal home. May his/her soul be bound up in the bond of life, in peace. Amen.

 I kindle this light in loving memory of _____, recalling words from the Book of Proverbs: "The soul of man is the light of the lord."

 Zekher tzadik livrakhah. The memory of the righteous is a blessing. May my life continue to embrace the life and deeds, the words and thoughts of _____ who has gone to his/her eternal home. May he/she rest in peace. Amen.

 O merciful God, I turn to You in prayer on the yahrzeit of the death of my dear _____. Be with me as I stand in remembrance and in loving recollection. As I light this candle in his/her memory, I put my trust in You.

 Renew my strength, O Lord. I am grateful for the years of the life of _____. Help me to understand how my life has been formed and shaped by what he/she was and by what he/she did. Help me to make part of my life a living monument of holiness to his/her memory. May he/she rest in peace. Amen.
