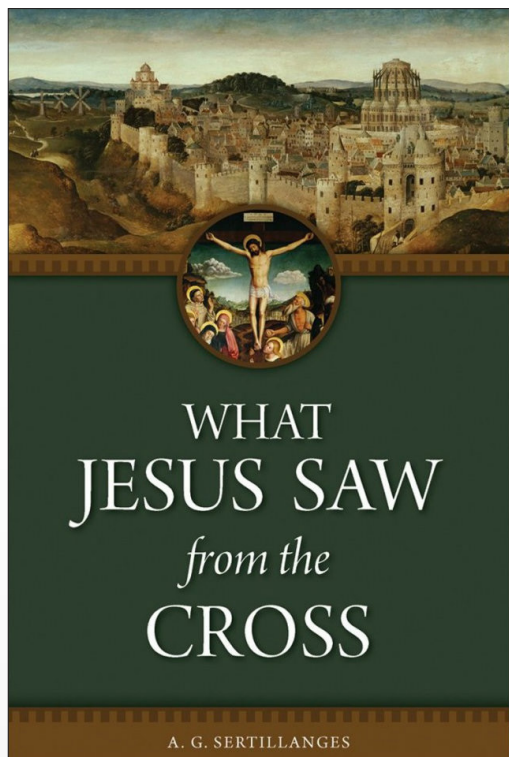

What Jesus Saw From the Cross

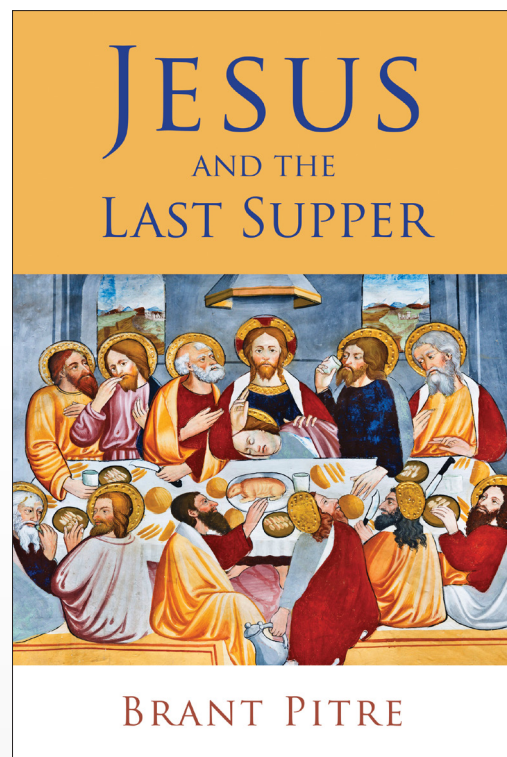

Jesus and the Last Supper

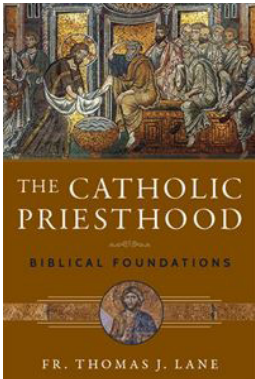

Situating the Last Supper in the triple contexts of ancient Judaism, the life of Jesus, and early Christianity, Pitre brings to light crucial insights into major issues driving the quest for Jesus. 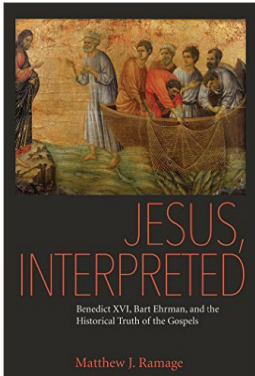


The Catholic Priesthood: Biblical Foundations

But with Christ’s death on the Cross, a new understanding of Christ as priest began to grow in light of his priestly self-sacrifice. *The Catholic Priesthood: Biblical Foundations* by Fr. Thomas Lane highlights the Scriptural evidence indicating that Christ’s intention was to establish a New Covenant priesthood that he would share with his apostles and their successors.

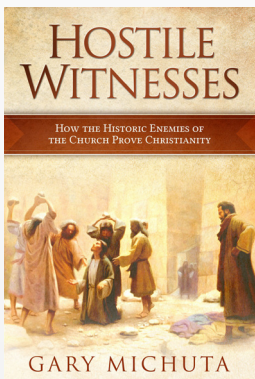


Jesus, Interpreted: Benedict XVI, Bart Ehrman, and the Historical Truth of the Gospels

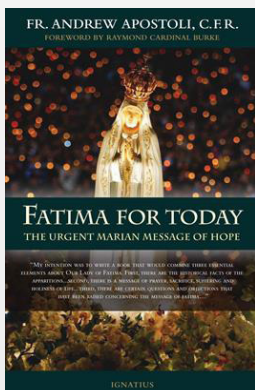


Reading the Sermons of Thomas Aquinas: A Beginner's Guide
