2. P3 Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Screening on 19 August 2020

The GEP identification exercise aims to identify pupils with high intellectual potential. All Primary 3 pupils studying in Singapore government and government-aided schools are eligible to participate in the Screening exercise.

Screening Exercise (Mathematics paper)

All topics in the Primary 1 to 3 Mathematics syllabus are included except for the topics of “Area and Perimeter”, “Geometry”, “Time” and “Fractions”.

Selection Exercise (Mathematics paper)

All topics in the Primary 1 to 3 Mathematics syllabus are included except for the topics of “Angles” and “Perpendicular and Parallel Lines” in Geometry and “Area and Perimeter”.

Screening Exercise (English Language)

The papers for English Language (EL) will continue to be based on the Primary 1 to Primary 3 EL syllabuses

3. Daily Temperature-Taking Exercise

Please ensure your child has a working thermometer and bring it to school every day as the school continues with daily temperature-taking in the classroom early morning.

4. Wearing of mask

All students are required to wear their mask to school and in school throughout the day.

5. CARES Value

Our focus on CARES value for Term 3 is Respect. We would like to encourage you to support our initiative by emphasizing this value to your child at home.

6. Parents Gateway

With the introduction of the Parents Gateway mobile app, all school announcements will now be broadcast via Parents Gateway. Do read announcements in Parents Gateway regularly to be kept updated of school programmes and events, and make consent.
