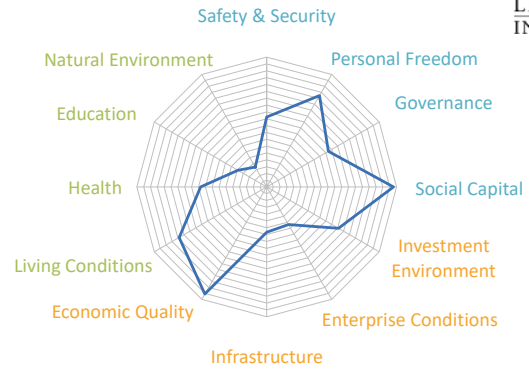
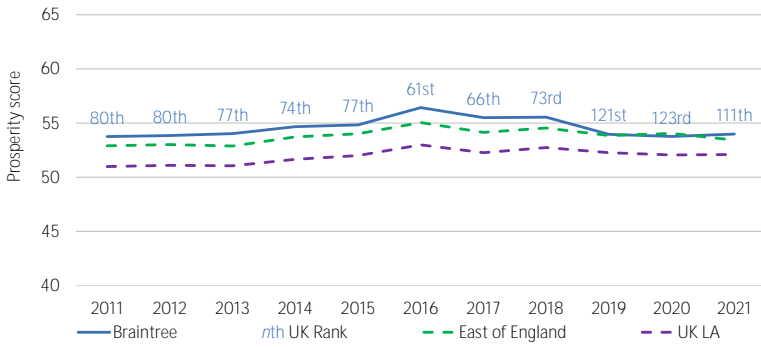


Braintree: Prosperity score 54.0 (111th)
