Introduction

2015 – 2017 RC F vehicles are equipped with high-friction brake pads, specifically designed for superior braking performance and response. As a result, the brakes may exhibit a squeal or squeak type noise.

For customers who find these characteristics objectionable, brake pads with alternative material are now available as service parts.

NOTE

ANY changes made to the brake pad material may result in altered and possibly reduced braking performance and/or feeling under certain driving conditions, including track use.

SERVICE MANAGER NOTE

Please note disclosures stated in the RC F sales information both in print form and online and discuss with the customer prior to installing the alternate brake pads listed in this service bulletin.

Installation Procedure

- 1. Remove and replace the front and rear brake pads with the alternative parts. Refer to the Technical Information System (TIS), applicable model and model year Repair Manual:
 - 2015 / 2016 / 2017 RC F: • Brake – Brake (Front) – "Brake (Front): Front Disc Brake Pad: Replacement"
 - <u>2015 / 2016 / 2017</u> RC F: Brake – Brake (Rear) – "Brake (Rear): Rear Disc Brake Pad: Replacement"

NOTICE

When performing this procedure, the front and rear brake pads MUST be replaced together to ensure proper brake system operation.

NOTE

When installing the front brake pads, ensure the single slit pad is installed on the inboard side of the calipers.
