What's New in Brava 7.2

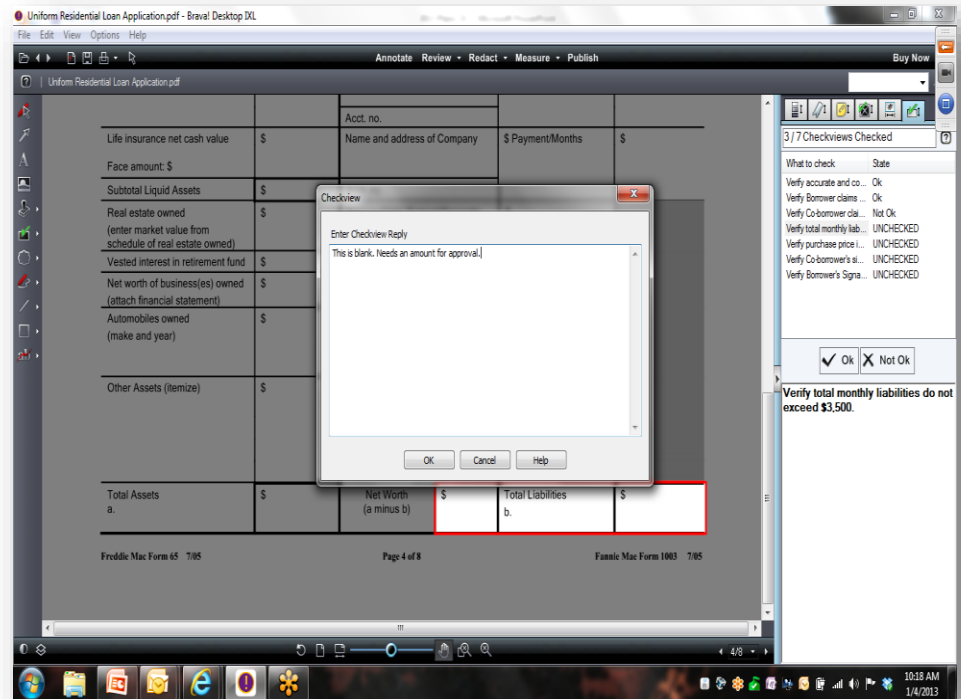
- Checkview
 - Markup entity that speeds up repetitive reviews
- Improved Document Compare
 - Change colors of compare features

- HTML Viewer is now vector based
 - Vector viewing for CAD support and crystal clear viewing
- Electronic Signatures
 - Brava now has electronic signatures and workflow eSignature steps
- Content Server 10.5 support (thumbnails in 7.2.1)

Checkview

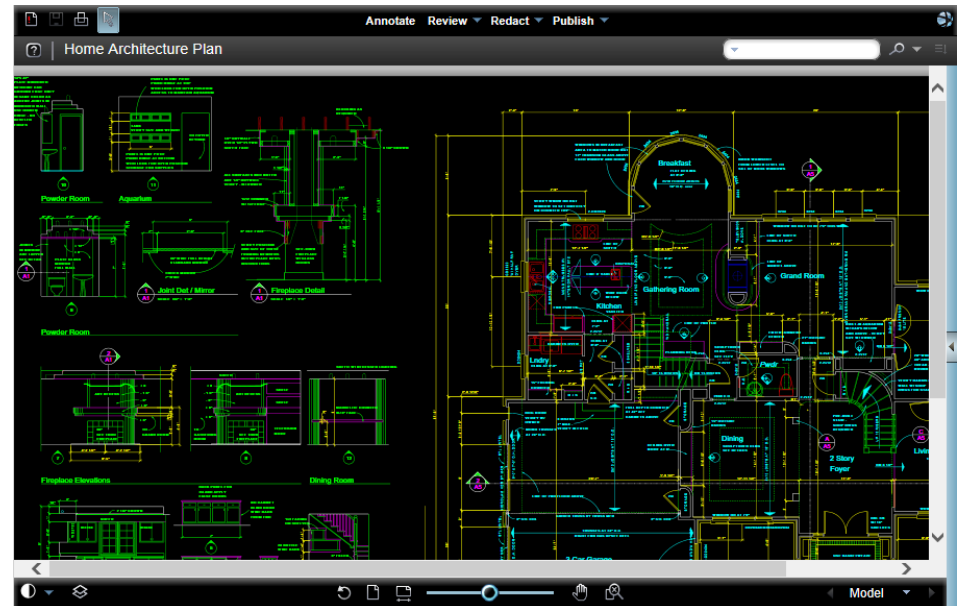
- Markup entity that speeds up repetitive reviews
- Make notes on areas - review and approve or reject
- Pans and zooms directly to area of interest



Brava for OpenText 7.2 (December 2013)

Brava HTML5 client – High Level Overview

- Supports vector viewing
- Crisp fonts and CAD geometry at any zoom level
- CAD users can control layer views
- See object attributes and hotspots
- Zoom, Pan and Magnify
- Great user experience on the Apple iPad

Detail of New Features – HTML5 Viewer 7.2

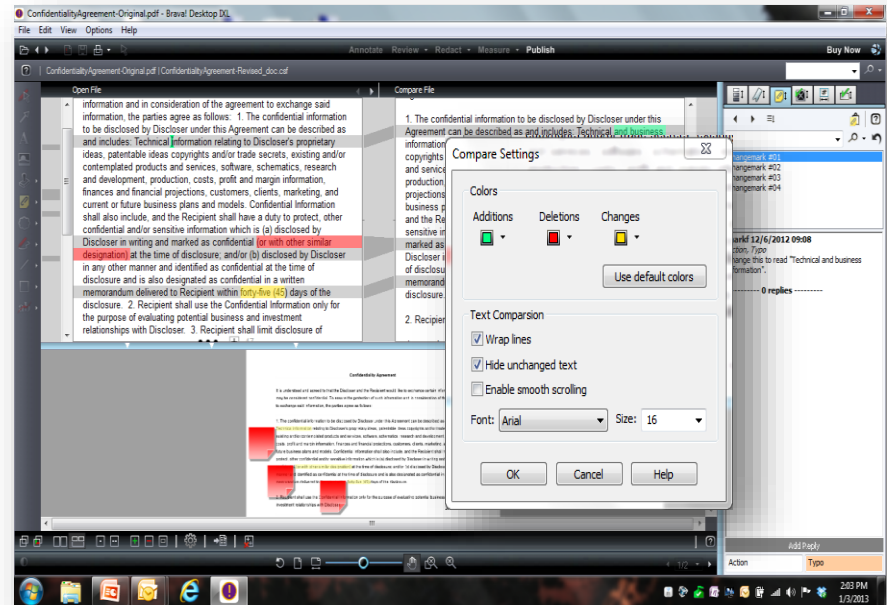
- Stamp support
- Redact “Allow Area” Tool
- Redaction Verify panel
- 508 compliance enhancements (keyboard accessibility)
- Support for background color selection
- Support for the download button on the full Desktop UI
- Support Regex Initial searches
- Support rotate of all pages in a document
- Support for selecting multiple markup entities
- Support for rendering of text annotation entities (strikeout, strikethrough, highlight & underline)
- Support for rendering of scratch out entities
- Search external API
- Raster Image selection dialog
- Raster name added to markup xml
- Markup text tool method of dragging a rectangle to set text area
- Ability to take ownership of other user's annotations
- Ability to create custom PDF and TIFF export dialogs
- Ability to disable Changemark replies
- CAD layers & Block Attributes/Hotspot support
- Redact Tools: Find & Redact From/To, Redact Page and Redact Privacy Info
- PDF Publishing Options: PDF/E and Fast Web View compatibility
- Pan/Zoom and Zoom Window Tools

- On Screen Banner/Watermark in viewing window
- Ability to theme Clients to match integration color schemes .
- Supports Simplified View Only UI that offers Print, Download, Search, Zoom, Rotate & Page navigation tools

Improved Document Text Compare

- Change colors of compare features
- Hide text with no changes
- Accuracy improvements



Brava for Content Server 7.2 SR1 (March 31st 2014)

- Support for Content Server email subtypes
- HTML Viewer integrated with Enterprise Connect
- TempoBox support (investigate, may be pushed to 7.3)
- License “Watched Groups” to apply to “Subgroups”
- Content Server 10.5 support for Thumbnails
- Add security options to doc merge publish to CSF
- DCS Indexing Module
- Various bug fixes

- Focus areas – Performance/Quality – High Level Overview
 - Server processing performance
 - Client download performance
 - Page/file download performance
 - Content Server integration stability
 - HTML Viewer functionality
 - 3D CAD Viewing
