If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Activities and Equipment**591-1-1-.12 Equipment & Toys(CR)****Not Met****Finding**

591-1-1-.12(3) requires that a variety of age-appropriate toys and play materials be available, stored on low, open shelves accessible to children in each room or assigned area. Toys that launch projectiles, such as dart guns, pop guns, slingshots, etc., shall not be allowed in the Center, and balloons shall not be accessible to preschool children. It was determined based on observation that Classrooms A, B and C were missing art supplies and Classrooms A and B were missing dramatic play supplies.

The Center director has placed an order for art supplies and dramatic play equipment. The center will also ensure that there is a variety of equipment for the children to play will.
