

A MISUNDERSTOOD WITCH defies gravity at the Gershwin Theater. Several blocks away, at the Majestic Theatre, a masked musical genius entrances a beautiful soprano with the music of the night. The Richard Rodgers Theatre is once

again the room where it happens. And magic carpets take flight at the New Amsterdam Theatre, transporting characters and audiences alike to a whole new world.

Yes, Broadway is back!

Great Performances pulls back the curtain on the highly anticipated return of Broadway following its unprecedented 18-month performance shutdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic in Reopening: The Broadway Revival, premiering this month on THIRTEEN, pbs.org/gperf, and the THIRTEEN app (thirteen.org/anywhere) as part of #PBSForTheArts, a multiplatform campaign celebrating the arts in America.
