

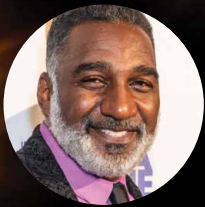

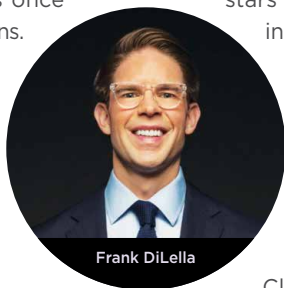

The Richard Rodgers Theatre is once again the room where it happens. And magic carpets take flight at the New Amsterdam Theatre, transporting characters and audiences alike to a whole new world.

Yes, Broadway is back!

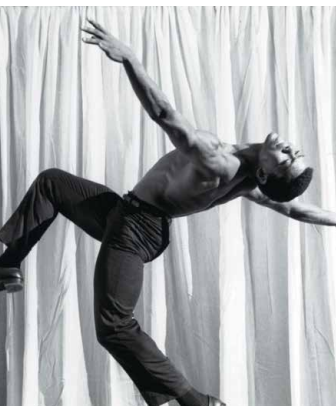
