ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones lost to the Staten Island Yankees by the score of 5-2 on Saturday night at MCU Park...OF Zach Ashford connected on his first professional home run, a solo blast in the third, but the Cyclones manged just two additional hits...LHP Andrew Edwards (0-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing an unearned run in the sixth.

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: Cyclones pitchers have thrown 16 wild pitches through the first eight games of the season, tied for second-most in the NYPL behind Mahoning Valley's 17.

RIDING THE INTERSTATE: Brooklyn is batting just .176 (44-250) as a team, tied with Staten Island for the lowest mark in the New York-Penn League...The Cyclones have also scored just 23 runs, fewest in the league... 20 of Brooklyn 44 hits have gone for extra bases.

IT'S ALL IN THE RISP: Brooklyn bats have struggled with runners in scoring position during this series, going $3-22$ in those situations with 10 runners left on base...Through the first eight games, Brooklyn is batting . 259 (14-54) with RISP...Brooklyn has scored more than four runs just one time this season and has scored exactly two runs in half of their games this season.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Corey Oswalt , a 2014 New York-Penn League All-Star, has joined the Cyclones as part of a MiLB Rehab assignment from Syracuse (AAA)...He made his first outing on Wednesday night, tossing 1.1 innings and allowing one run on three hits...INF Gavin Cecchini was added to the Cyclones roster prior to Sunday's game as part of his MiLB Rehab Assignment...The former 1st round selection has not appeared in a game this season due to a quad injury...Cecchini played with Brooklyn in 2012 and 2013, batting .273 (53-194) in 51 games during the 2013 season.
vs. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 118-115 against the Staten Island Yankees all-time...The 118 wins are the most wins the Cyclones have against any opponent...Brooklyn is 2-2 against the Yankees this year, including 1-1 at MCU Park...The Cyclones are 63-55 all-time on Coney Island and 55-60 all-time at Richmond County Bank Ballpark at St. George.

BUT THERE'S A CATCH: C Jake Ortega was added to the Cyclones roster on Friday from the 2019 MLB Draft...Ortega pinch-hit in the ninth inning last night, flying out to right field...He was a 28th-round selection from Cal State-Bakersfield, leading the team with a .326 average and a .418 OBP this spring.

FULL HOUSE: The Cyclones and Yankees played in front of a crowd of 8,031 on Friday night...That was the largest crowd at MCU Park since August 29, 2015 when the team welcomed 9,156 fans through the gates.

FEELING A DRAFT: Brooklyn has hit three home runs this season, and all three have been hit by players selected in the 2019 MLB Draft: 1B Joe Genord, 2B Luke Ritter, and OF Zach Ashford.

DON'T CROSS THE STREAMS: The Cyclones will be the first - and only - team in Minor League Baseball who will stream games through Facebook Live this season...Brooklyn will stream all 38 home games exclusively through Facebook Live as part of a partnership with Sling Studio...All other MiLB teams that offer streaming must use MiLB TV.

SUNDAY: The Cyclones will close out their threegame series with the Staten Island Yankees with Jewish Heritage Night...The first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Mensch on a Bench Bobblehead.
