the rules

Broughty Gala Week's *legendary* Window Guessing Competition, first started way back in 1932, and the rules are exactly the same today! All the participating shops and businesses are members of The Broughty Ferry Traders' Association, and have displayed in their windows an article which they do not sell. The object of the competition is for young people (under 14) to look at the windows and discover what the 'odd' article is. For instance in the Baker's shop you might find a teapot or in the newsagent, a paint brush. **Remember, sometimes it will be hard to spot, but children should not go into shops and ask for clues!** The participating shops have a Red Diamond with a number on it in their window, which corresponds to the number on the entry form on the following page.
