

**BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2021**

The Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and the Buffalo County Board of Equalization met on Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at 9:00 A.M. and 9:30 A.M. County Clerk Janice Giffin called the Reorganization Meeting of the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners to order and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. The following Board members responded to roll call: Timothy Higgins, Ivan Klein, Myron Kouba, Ronald Loeffelholz, Daniel Lynch, Sherry Morrow and William McMullen. A copy of the acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda by the Board of Commissioners is attached to these minutes. Public notice of this meeting was published/posted in the Kearney Hub, on the Buffalo County web site, and the bulletin boards located outside the County Clerk's office and County Board Room on January 7, 2021. In accordance with Section 84-1412 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is available for review and is posted at the back of the Board Room. County Clerk Janice Giffin took all proceedings hereinafter shown; while the convened meeting was open to the public.

County Clerk Janice Giffin called for the election of a Chairman. Commissioner Morrow nominated William McMullen for Chairman of the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and Klein seconded the nomination. County Clerk Giffin called for any further nominations three times. There were no further nominations brought forward and nominations ceased with a unanimous ballot for William McMullen. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Lynch and McMullen. Motion declared carried and William McMullen is the 2021 Board Chairman.

County Clerk Giffin turned the meeting over to Chairman McMullen.

Chairman McMullen called for the election of a Vice Chairman. Commissioner Morrow nominated Ivan Klein as Vice Chairman of the Buffalo County Board of Commissioners and Kouba seconded the nomination. Chairman McMullen called for any further nominations three times. There were no further nominations and the nominations ceased with a unanimous ballot for Ivan Klein. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Kouba, Higgins, Klein, Loeffelholz, Lynch and McMullen. Motion declared carried and Ivan Klein is the 2021 Board Vice Chairman.

RESOLUTION 2021-02

WHEREAS, Buffalo County has adopted an Employee Handbook, and

WHEREAS, periodic updates to said handbook are necessary to maintain legal compliance, to adjust policies, to add or remove policies, and/or to correct errors,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

Sec 6.22 shall be amended to add the following line:

If you have obtained appropriate preauthorization to use your personal vehicle for Business travel you will be reimbursed at the cents per-mile rate set forth by the Internal Revenue Service each year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

These changes take effect immediately and an updated version of the Employee Handbook will be made available on Knowledge Base within 7 days.

Chairman McMullen opened the discussion for Family First Coronavirus Response Act policy (FFCRA). Moved by Klein and seconded by Kouba to approve the extension of FFCRA with the following Resolution 2020-03. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Klein, Kouba, Higgins, Loeffelholz, Lynch, Morrow and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

RESOLUTION 2021-03

WHEREAS, Buffalo County has previously implemented procedures to provide for Emergency Paid Sick Leave and Emergency Paid Family and Medical Leave as required by the Family First Coronavirus Response Act ("FFCRA"); and

WHEREAS, Buffalo County has previously implemented procedures to provide for paid sick leave for employees not covered by the Family First Coronavirus Response Act; and

WHEREAS, the mandatory emergency paid sick leave provisions within the Family First Coronavirus Response Act expired on December 31, 2020 and were replaced by an option to voluntarily extend these forms of paid leave under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act; and

WHEREAS, Buffalo County wishes to extend these provisions on a voluntary basis to eligible employees who have not already used these benefits.

WHEREAS, Buffalo County recognizes that, due to the nature of the Covid-19 pandemic policies and procedures must remain flexible and adaptable to changing circumstances, public health needs, and local, state, and federal regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

Prior policies implemented under the Family First Coronavirus Response Act and the Counties supplemental procedures for employees not covered by the FFCRA shall be extended through March 31, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

This extension shall be handled retroactively to January 1, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

This is a continuation of previously granted benefits and not a restarting of said benefits. Employees who have already exhausted their prior benefits under these policies are not eligible for additional supplemental leave, however can continue to use their paid leave or the protections of the Family Medical Leave Act. Employees who have partially exhausted their prior benefits may be eligible to use the remainder of these benefits through March 31, 2021. Employees who have not used these benefits remain eligible for the full benefits as outlined in the FFCRA or other policies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

This may be further extended upon action of the Board or may be superseded or replaced by applicable state or federal law without further action of the Board.

Prior to this meeting, Brian Cox resigned from the Extension Board via correspondence on file with the Extension Office. Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Klein to recognize the resignation of Extension Board member Brian Cox and to appoint Brad Krohn to fill the remainder of that term that ends in 2022. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Lynch, Morrow and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Morrow and seconded by Klein to approve the release of pledged collateral in the amount of \$130,000.00 from the NebraskaLand National Bank for the Buffalo County Treasurer. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Morrow, Klein, Higgins, Kouba, Loeffelholz, Lynch and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

WHEREAS, Buffalo County passed the operation of keno in unincorporated areas at the November 3, 2020 General Election,
WHEREAS, Buffalo County plans to receive money to be used for community betterment,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper that Buffalo County create a budgetary fund for the account of the receipts and the expenditures of said fund. Fund #2850 was assigned by the State Auditor's Office for the "Keno Lottery Fund".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that Buffalo County creates a fund to be known as "Keno Lottery Fund" number #2850 on Buffalo County's accounting and budgeting system.

Chairman McMullen reviewed the following correspondence. Central Plains Valuation, LLC sent an introductory letter inquiring about 2021 Buffalo County Protest Referee Hearings. The Open Meetings Act Draft including Senator Flood's requested changes was received and the Assistant Deputy State Auditor/Nebraska Auditor of Public Accounts sent an email in regards to the 2021 Mileage Rates. The Kearney Area Chamber of Commerce (KACC) sent an invite to the 102nd Annual Virtual Meeting on January 25, 2021. The City of Kearney sent the Planning Commission Agenda for the January 15, 2021 meeting. Chairman McMullen called on each Board member present for committee reports and recommendations.

Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Lynch to recess the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:31 A.M. and reconvene as a Board of Equalization. Upon roll call vote, the following Board members voted "Aye": Loeffelholz, Lynch, Higgins, Klein, Kouba, Morrow and McMullen. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Loeffelholz and seconded by Higgins to adjourn the Board of Equalization and return to the regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners at 9:35 A.M. Statement of Finding

The failure to control noxious weeds on lands in this state is a serious problem, which is detrimental to the production of crops and livestock, to the welfare of residents of this state and which may devalue land, and reduces tax revenue (Neb. Rev. Stat. 2-945.02 (1)).

Section 2-954 of the Nebraska Noxious Weed Control Act requires each weed control authority to establish a coordinated program for the control of noxious weeds within the county.

First Goal, Continue to Educate the public on noxious and invasive weeds.

Educating the public will never stop there is always going to be new and improved methods of controlling weeds. It will always be a goal of ours to educate as many Buffalo County landowners that we can in any given year. The more information we get out to the public will serve us better in the future and it will make our jobs easier so we will have more time to learn new ways of controlling weeds. The best way we get information out to the public is by having booths set up at the State Fair and Husker Harvest days. We also have many educational brochures at the weed control office and we would like to set one up in the courthouse in the future.

Second Goal, Continue to provide commercial spraying for the landowners of Buffalo County.

Providing commercial spraying for our landowners in Buffalo County is a great asset to have. It helps the landowner out who might have let a pasture get away from them and allows us to get it back to a manageable state to where the landowner can then do it himself in the future. We will continue to only spray noxious weeds, because they are our primary focus and gives us more time to focus on noxious weeds in right-of-ways and tributaries.

Third Goal, Continue to work on right-of-ways, tributaries, and bodies of water.

Focusing on these areas will help us keep noxious weeds at bay. Right-of-ways are one of the worst ways that noxious weeds spread, mowing is a good way to get rid of the weeds, but also helps spread them. Once they are in the right-of-way they can spread on to landowners and cause us more problems in the future. Tributaries getting infested with noxious weeds and spreading onto our river systems causes so many problems that could lead to major flooding if we do not keep them clean. Focusing on these areas are vital to the spread of noxious weeds.

General

Well achieving last year's goals was a lot harder than one would think; normally we are dealing with Mother Nature throwing curveballs at us left and right. This year was different and I think we would all agree 2020 should never be brought up again. With Covid 19 being a huge factor of why we did not achieve some of our goals. Spraying was a bit tough when we were limited to working 4 days a week and working with Mother Nature did not give us a whole lot of days to spray but we made the most of it. Education side was tough when a lot of the meeting were canceled and social distancing made it hard to meet with landowners. With that being said, I really hope we have a better 2021 season.

Noxious Weed Enforcement

 - C. Inquire into the plans of those controlling the ground; as to what action they propose to take, if possible.
 - D. Advise party of possible methods to gain compliance.
 - E. Allow superintendent to use some discretion in giving limited time for landowners to comply or to make arrangements with others.
 - F. Monitor ground during discretionary time period to ascertain compliance.

 - A. The specific steps the control authority will take when issuing a 10-day notices.
 1. Physical inspection to document noxious weed infestations by the superintendent or his assistants.
 2. Photographic evidence compiled at on-site infestation.
 3. Inquire to Register of Deeds as to current ownership.
 4. Determination of legal address of owner from Treasurer's Office from the statement records, if in doubt Register of Deeds can cross-reference.
 5. Compilation of inspection reports.
 6. Normal service made by registered mail return receipt requested.
 7. Personal service by Sheriff's Office if mail refused. (when necessary)
 8. Documentation of all responses received after issuance.

 - B. Assuming that the 10-day has been issued, the next steps are as follows:
 1. Document and return receipt from notice to start the countdown from the date of receipt unless unreasonable delays were encountered.
 2. Staff will make at least two on-sight inspections during the 10-day period and document

these inspections.

3. Document all contracts with landowners and agents.
4. Document in writing any variances given on notice.
5. Stage the final inspection on the expiration date or as close as possible after the date.
6. Build file on the notice with follow up inspection reports and final photographic evidence of non-compliance prior to force controlling.

C. Upon expiration of the legal notice the enforcement action procedures are as follows:

Ten Day

1. Photographic documentation on date control starts to verify actual stages of growth.
2. If compliance in question, we may contact landowner for additional explanation.
3. County crew will begin control work or containment action under the orders of the superintendent.
4. Control Authority may be contacted prior to implementation of control work if situation anticipated being highly volatile.
5. Notification of landowner of the cost of said control work within a reasonable time period.

Public Awareness

Buffalo County Weed Control does a good job of public awareness just by going out and spraying, landowners will see our equipment and a lot of the times will call to have theirs done as well. Buffalo County is always looking for new ideas to get the awareness out. Just going and talking to landowners is good way to spread the information about noxious weeds. Just getting out and having a good, relationship with the landowners will go a long way. Working with the NWCA, we will be able to spread the awareness at Husker Harvest Days and State Fair. Having more newspaper articles throughout the growing season is going to benefit us getting the awareness out. We would like to have weed tours and a landowners meeting in the near future.
