

## Transportation Demand Management City Ordinance Requirements

- 1. Certify an Employee Transportation Coordinator
- 2. Survey employees about how they get to work
- Create a plan that increases the number of people walking, biking, riding transit, and carpooling to work.



- Active Buy Local Santa Monica member

#### **Social Responsibility**

- Employee sick pay & health insurance at half cost
- Student employment opportunities during peak summer season
- Demonstrate commitment to supporting community i.e., giving \$, donating venue/ foodware for events, participating

- Sustainability featured prominently in mission statement
- Foodservice leader in eliminating plastic to-go-ware per Santa Monica's revised Disposable Food Service Ware ordinance

- Provides \$ 1.25 million annually in financial aid for families in need


- Environmental sustainability <u>incorporated into all aspects</u> including curriculum, procurement, construction, student life etc.
