Welcome to the 2020 OSA Summer Convention

We are excited to host this year's conference at Eagle Crest Resort in Redmond, Oregon. We have planned an agenda and activities that we hope will both educate and entertain, and at a new venue that offers many activities for adults and families alike.

The following pages contain the preliminary agenda, registration rates and information, and details about group and individual activities.

Eagle Crest Resort offers many activities for all ages. The resort has two championship golf courses, as well as an 18-hole, par 63 challenge course. Guests of all ages will enjoy the 18-hole putting course, where players 17 and under play for free in the afternoons.

The resort has three sports centers, as well as tennis, basketball, volleyball and racquetball courts, fully equipped fitness centers and classes, year-round hot tubs, a game room, and an indoor pool and outdoor pools and splash park. Games and bikes can be rented as well. See pages 9-12 for more information about these activities.

Convention activities will begin on Thursday, June 18, with golf at the Resort Course. Also on Thursday, will be the Second Annual Texas Hold-Em poker tournament fundraiser. Half of the proceeds will go to the OSA scholarship fund, and the other half paid out to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. Sign up now as more players mean bigger payouts for players and scholarship recipients! Snacks and drinks will be provided as well as a no-host bar.



"Moving Forward Together: Conflict, Collaboration, Communication"

How can the OSA overcome competing interests, historical rifts and shifting allegiances to achieve greater success for both the organization and its individual members? In this session, you'll learn the vital qualities of a healthy business ecosystem; how to identify and mitigate sources of conflict; how "co-opetition" can be harnessed for the greater good; and the communications skills you need to become a more effective advocate for your business and industry.



Kellie M. Boyle Partner, Boyle Public Affairs

Kellie Boyle is a partner at Washington, DC-based Boyle Public Affairs, which she co-founded in 2011. She manages a team of experts in strategizing and executing PR and digital marketing campaigns on behalf of their clients, which have included the American Seed Trade Association, CropLife America, United Fresh Produce Association and Southwestern Fertilizer Conference.

Kellie began her career in political communications guiding candidates, office holders and political parties at the national and state levels. Over the next twelve years, she had a front row seat to – and played an active role in – some of the country's most controversial and culture-changing initiatives: in the early 1990's, she helped to calm a confused and divided populace through the "America Responds to AIDS" campaign. In the mid-90's, she helped businesses leverage the new Internet and compete in the nascent digital economy. And in 1997, as part of a national advocacy campaign, she represented whistleblower Jeffrey Wigand, who was later played by Russell Crowe in the movie, "The Insider."

Over the following decade, Kellie counseled such clients as The Conservation Fund, Small Business Administration, American Red Cross and Veterans Administration. In recent years, she has partnered with organizational development firms and conducted media and communications seminars for associations throughout the country.
