From the desk of the Mayor

On behalf of the Mayor and Council, I would like to wish our residents a Happy and Healthy New Year. We are very excited for what is ahead in 2020!

In 2018 and 2019 we were able to pass a budget with a 0% municipal tax increase while still allocating additional funding for infrastructure, making significant improvements to our recreational facilities, increasing the amount of Police officers, providing our emergency services with the tools they need to succeed and much more. We believe that by continuing to make the right investments in Fair Lawn, our community will continue to thrive.

Improvements continue at Memorial Pool, which has seen a significant increase in membership. The 2020 season includes the addition of a new splash park and the beginning stages of a new Administration building. We will also be making improvements at Dobrow Complex and LaPoff Park.

Moving forward, we will be reviewing one different playground and sports field each year to make sure Fair Lawn continues to have some of the best recreation facilities in the County.

Additional improvements in pedestrian safety are also slated for 2020, with the addition of three new rectangular rapid flashing beacons within the Borough and three new crosswalks on Morlot Avenue. Increased funding has been allocated for road resurfacing and we look forward to getting those projects started in the spring of 2020.

I want to thank our Borough employees, whose work and commitment ensures the Borough continues to run smoothly, and recognize the dedicated service and advocacy of our many resident volunteers. Fair Lawn is also blessed to have dedicated first responders – Police, Fire, Rescue and Ambulance- who give selflessly to protect and serve our residents.

Lastly, I want to thank you – our residents – for making the important decision to choose Fair Lawn as your home. Collectively you make our Borough a diverse, interesting and caring place to live. It has been a pleasure for the Council and I to work with you this past year and hear your thoughts on how we can make Fair Lawn an even greater community. Your input is sincerely appreciated.

Solutions to Stormwater Pollution

WHAT IS STORMWATER POLLUTION?

Water from rain and melting snow that flows over lawns, parking lots and streets is known as stormwater runoff. This water, which travels along gutters, into catch basins and through storm drain pipes and ditches, usually is not treated, but then flows or is discharged into local waterbodies. Along the way, the stormwater picks up trash (fast-food wrappers, cigarette butts, styrofoam cups, etc.) and toxins and other pollutants (gas, motor oil, antifreeze, fertilizers, pesticides and pet droppings). This polluted stormwater can kill fish and other wildlife, destroy wildlife habitat, contaminate drinking water sources and force the closing of beaches because of health threats to swimmers.

Human activity is largely responsible for the stormwater pollution. Everything that we put on the ground or into the storm drain can end up in our water. Each of us has a responsibility to make sure these contaminants stay out of our water. Whether we have clean water is up to you.

- Limit your use of fertilizers and pesticides
- Properly use and dispose of hazardous products
- Keep pollution out of storm drains
- Clean up after your pet

- Don't feed wildlife
- Don't litter
- Dispose of yard waste properly

Disabled Veteran Exemptions Available

Veterans that have been deemed to be 100% disabled by the United States Veteran's Administration as the result of a service-connected disability may be entitled to a full property tax exemption. Contact the Tax Assessor for eligibility requirements and application claim forms.

Senior Citizens, Disabled Persons and Veteran Deductions New Applications Only: Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons who meet certain income requirements are eligible for a tax deduction of \$250.



Residential Special Needs

The Borough of Fair Lawn Office of Emergency Management has established a Residential Special Needs Registry for citizens who may require special attention during times of emergency. If you or someone you know is using oxygen in their home, requires a walker to get around, or has any other form of disability, fill out an application. All information is kept confidential and is distributed to the police, fire, rescue, ambulance, health, and public works departments for use during emergency. Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

CERT members give critical support to first responders in emergencies, provide immediate assistance to victims, organize spontaneous volunteers at a disaster site, and collect disaster intelligence to support first responder efforts. If you join a CERT, you will receive basic-level training in Emergency Preparedness, Disaster Medical Operations, Fire Suppression, Light Search and Rescue Operations, Incident Command System, Disaster Psychology, Terrorism Awareness and Community Animal Response Team. Total training is usually about 20 hours, scheduled in 2-4 hour modules, over a period of weeks. Training courses, student materials and equipment are provided free of charge. 




Dog licenses are due in December 2020. All dogs over 6 months must be licensed. Owners must show proof of rabies vaccination good through November 1, 2021 in order to obtain a 2021 dog license. The license fees are: \$12.00 (spayed/neutered) or \$15.00 (unspayed/unneutered). There is an addition \$10 fee for a dog license renewal obtained after January 1st. Residents are urged to license their dogs to avoid summonses to municipal court. For info on 3-year licenses, or if your dog's rabies shot expires prior to November 1, 2021, call 201-794-5327.


