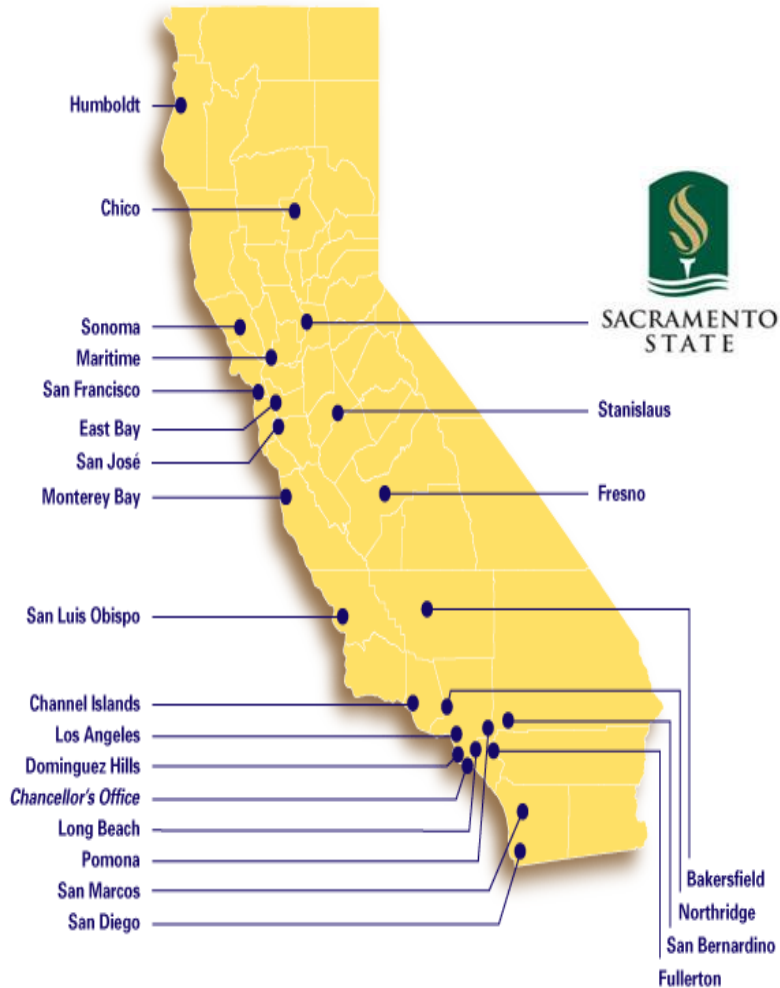

New SAT

- CSU campuses will accept old and new SAT scores from students currently in grades 9 – 12 (graduating in 2020 or prior) for admission eligibility and exemption from the Entry Level Mathematics and English Placement Test.
- Campuses may “Superscore” with like tests only.
- The essay is still not required

New SAT – FTF Eligibility Index

Application Cycle	Admit Terms	Resident Eligibility Index	Non-Resident Eligibility Index
2016-2017	Fall 2017 & Spring 2018	2900	3502
2017-2018	Fall 2018 & Spring 2019	2950	3570

The SAT eligibility index formula will remain the same: SAT (scores in math and EBRW) + (800 x high school grade point average).

Freshman Admission Eligibility

- High school graduation
- A-G completion
- Eligibility index (GPA and test scores)

- CSU does not include Writing section of ACT or SAT to determine eligibility index

- 1/4 of CSU campuses admit freshman applicants based only on CSU eligibility

Transfer Admission Eligibility

- 60 semester/90 quarter units
 - 30 units of General Education
 - Including Golden Four (Area A & B4)
 - Grades of C or higher
- 2.0 GPA in transferable college work
- Good standing at last institution of attendance

- 1/3 of CSU campuses admit transfer applicants based only on CSU eligibility

Admissions & Impaction

- **Campus Impaction:** A campus receives more eligible applications in the initial filing period than there are enrollment spaces available for the class level (freshman or upper division transfer).
- **Program Impaction:** A campus receives more eligible applications for a specific undergraduate program in the initial filing period than there are enrollment spaces available

The priority deadline to apply for Fall 2017 admission as an undergraduate student is November 30, 2016 and may vary for international and graduate students. Preparation and Readiness

- Admitting on self-report information-accuracy is very important!
- Student name given in the application for admission must match the name used to register for SAT/ACT.
- Take four years of math
- Early Assessment Program
 - Juniors to take ACT/SAT in spring
 - Satisfy remediation through high school experience before enrolling
- Pursue Associates Degree for Transfer and complete all lower division requirements
