40 DAYS FOR LIFE™ BATON ROUGE

September 23 to November 1

This fall, Baton Rouge, is uniting with cities around the world in 40 Days for Life, the largest simultaneous interdenominational pro-life effort in history. A focused campaign of prayer, vigil and outreach, 40 Days for Life seeks to bring an end to the tragedy of abortion. Since 2007, it has:

- mobilized over 650,000 people worldwide in 579 cities
- saved more than 10,331 babies from abortion
- led post-abortive women and men to healing

During Baton Rouge's fourth campaign last year, 21 babies were confirmed saved and over 1,300 people gathered to pray for an end to abortion. Come join this prayerful campaign!

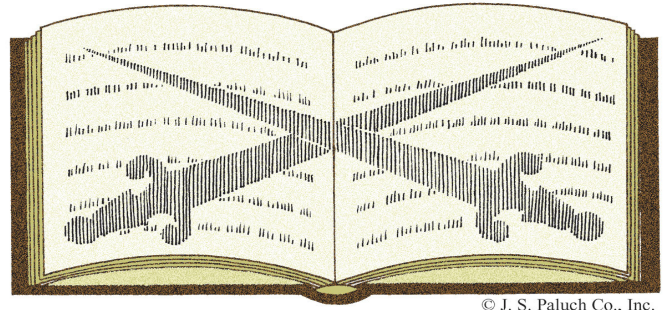

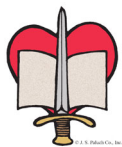
