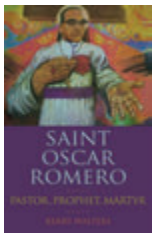
Thursday, November 1st is All Saints Day

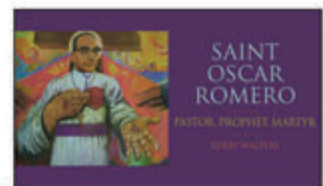
