

Dear Parents of Radiant Montessori Center Children,






Hello Casa Two families!

Casa 3 families,

In Language, it was cold and the children explored winter weather and Antarctic animals through a new Antarctic Card work. They learned about ice, snow, and diverse animals in the area with discussions and the aesthetic sensorial card material. On the other hand, they also learned indirectly the southern hemisphere's weather and animals, Australian animals that they could not meet easily. They also explored other culture's New Year celebration in East Asia. As last Friday night (Jan 27th) was the new day of Chinese calendar, they learned about how



other culture cerebrated in a different style and date multi-culturally.

For Math, I focused especially on the children's mathematical mind that was based on the order of perceptual awareness found on the development of the senses in Math and Science. Especially their transition of mathematical perception from simple (concrete) to complex (abstract) in the Montessori Method. Our children already had the acquisition of quantity from tangible beads (Golden Beads, Color Beads) at the casa. From their familiar and concrete perception from the materials, they had impressions of symbolic and infinite dimension of numbers through Math works.

For Practical Life, I brought some food works at the casa: Making lemon juice, Grinding a cinnamon stick, Spreading butter and jam, and Making apple sauce work. Along with the Practical Life works, they continued our sensorial journey, too. Through food preparation, making food with friends socially, cleaning up with their sensorial perceptions, they used all their senses: Visual, Tactile, Baric, Thermic, Auditory, Olfactory, and Gustatory. Although these Practical Life looked easy and simple, the children used and refined all their senses and muscles while doing the works.

Sincerely, thanks for the donation of books through the Book Fair. Our children can have more chances to explore the world indirectly with them that open their eyes and hearts by reading and hearing.
