Duties/Responsibilities

- Report to work on time and with appropriate safety equipment and uniform. Expectation of professionalism, presenting a confident appearance, ready to act or assist members or guests all times.

- Performing regularly scheduled light cleaning maintenance duties, i.e., returning equipment to storage, pool configuration changes, pool chemistry checks, pool brushing, hosing, vacuuming and general clean up tasks as assigned, or needed.

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
