To respond to the public health crisis caused by the global COVID-19 pandemic, a swift, coordinated effort across many sectors of society is necessary, said NIH Director Francis Collins, MD, PhD, and Johnson & Johnson Vice Chairman of the Executive Committee and Chief Scientific Officer Paul Stoffels, MD, in a Viewpoint published yesterday in *JAMA*. "The main goals ... are to establish a collaborative framework for prioritizing vaccine and therapeutic candidates, to streamline clinical trials and tap into existing clinical trial networks, and to coordinate regulatory processes and leverage assets among all partners," they wrote.





### AAMC and CFAS Address Racism and Police Brutality

- The AAMC responded to . racial violence with a statement and call to action against police brutality and racism in America
- More than 30 CFAS societies and other organizations signed onto the statement, and 34 others shared their own statements – all were published on the CFAS website

# **AAMC Strategic Planning Update**

- Well underway before the pandemic and the protests over racism captured the attention of the academic medicine community, the AAMC strategic plan has now been adapted to comprehensively address both topics and their intersections of long-standing health inequities in America
- 10 action plans are being modeled and drafted by teams of AAMC staff. As those plans crystalize, CFAS will restart its work on a strategic planning process to align the council with the AAMC's goals.

#### About the AAMC's Strategic Planning Process

President and CEO David Skorton is personally leading the AAMC's strategic planning team, which includes members of the AAMC Board of Directors and the AAMC Leadership Team.

The process began with a comprehensive <u>scan of the</u> <u>environment</u> to identify the challenges and opportunities that will affect society; patients, families, and communities; health care and academic medicine; associations and nonprofits; and the AAMC itself.

With the environmental scan completed, the process focused on updating the AAMC mission and vision statements and identifying broad themes and goals to address the challenges and opportunities identified in the environmental scan. More than 1,500 members of AAMC's affinity groups viewed the draft themes and goals and provided critical feedback and insight.

- GME funding advocacy






