


Isabel has 12 badges.






8 There were 341 adults at a sports event.

There were 531 fewer adults than children at the sports event. How many children were there at the sports event?




639 students visited a science center on Monday.

How many students visited the science center on Tuesday?




10 A gardener planted 14 sunflower seeds.

He planted 6 fewer daisy flower seeds than sunflower seeds. How many daisy flower seeds did the gardener plant?






A baker baked 124 pies and some muffins.
