



Recent years have brought many changes to healthcare, but none will compare with 2020. The coronavirus pandemic did not just dominate healthcare news; it dominated every aspect of our lives.

Yet, looking back over the last year, it is worth asking ourselves what we have learned and where do we go from here? One thing is certain;

the pandemic validated that entering the primary care space was a sound decision for AltaPointe Health and its patients.

AltaPointe began providing integrated behavioral and primary health care because "whole-person" care is best for our patients. We could not have imagined how the pandemic would hasten this trajectory and highlight its benefits.

The COVID-19 pandemic escalated quickly across Alabama, going from zero cases in mid-March 2020 to more than 16,000 in late May. While many organizations were caught off guard, AltaPointe Health was not. Our providers moved quickly into testing for the coronavirus and later into vaccinating staff in high-risk environments. The use of advanced telehealth solutions in our established primary care offices put us ahead of the curve. When the pandemic hit, AltaPointe was already entrenched in primary care so that we could aid the most vulnerable of people.

The pandemic served as a catalyst to launch us even deeper into whole-person care, and we experienced phenomenal growth on the primary care side. We opened two additional Accordia Health offices, one designed specifically for the integrated care of children and leading to the hiring of our first pediatrician.

We also saw a dramatic increase in the use of telehealth across our continuum. Even before the COVID-19 outbreak, it was evident that the popularity of virtual care was rising. Data collected in this report reflects a 700 percent increase in the use of telehealth to connect with and treat our patients physically and mentally. Telehealth allowed many people to garner the courage and confidence to seek mental health treatment for the first time.

Several key advances have improved quality within our continuum and collectively across the system, including our ability to look at people not just through the mental health lens but also the primary care lens. We recognize with greater clarity that social determinants of health such as economic stability, education, and access to care are central to our healthcare system's health and wellness puzzle. We use this information to identify the most vulnerable populations and give our providers meaningful insights into the health of our patients.

The pandemic has been stressful and has placed enormous pressure on our staff, our hospitals, and our healthcare continuum at large. At the same time, it has been a tremendous facilitator for learning and growth. We learned how resilient we are and that it is better to chart a new course in healthcare collectively.





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

Total Operating Revenue – FY 2020













Ethnicity of Patients Served – FY 2020





Gender of Patients Served - FY 2020












Most Prevalent Diagnoses – FY 2020






AltaPointe Health's Hospital Services


AltaPointe operates two free-standing psychiatric hospitals: BayPointe Hospital located in Mobile, which is a 104-bed facility with inpatient and residential, and a 75 person capacity day treatment program with an educational component and a 120 person capacity after-school day treatment program; and EastPointe Hospital, an 82-bed facility in Daphne, offers a 66-bed adult inpatient crisis stabilization unit and a 16-bed adult crisis residential unit. AltaPointe's ownership of these inpatient facilities and its ability to provide inpatient care make it the most comprehensive behavioral healthcare system in Alabama.

Involuntary 54% • Voluntary 46%






Patient assessment and consultation made safer through technology

AltaPointe Health's telehealth and ConsultPointe services allow AltaPointe staff to better serve patients in remote locations or hospitals without psychiatric services available onsite. These services bring AltaPointe psychiatrists, therapists, and patients face-to-face through videoconferencing. In response to coronavirus-related health and safety concerns, AltaPointe's telehealth services expanded to include telephone consultations as well. AltaPointe staff provided more than 111,000 telehealth services during 2020; an increase of more than 700% from the previous year. Using telehealth improves assessment, processes, timeliness, and outcomes for patients.

Total Telehealth Services Provided by Region – FY 2020










Ethnicity of Patients Served – FY 2020










Most Prevalent Primary Care Diagnoses – FY 2020




Most Prevalent Psychiatric Diagnoses – FY 2020



Gender of Patients Served – FY 2020



Total Services Provided - FY 2020










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Gender of Patients Served – FY 2020





Access, Crisis and Other Calls








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Patient Overall Satisfaction – FY 2020



Hospital Services Overall Satisfaction – FY 2020


