
## **CARE AND CLEANING**

**DO NOT** scratch or chip the finish. **DO NOT** use abrasive chemicals for cleaning. Clean with mild soap on a soft rag. Rinse and dry thoroughly. If the crib is to be stored, store in a cool dry place and carefully package all original hardware to protect from loss.

## **TOOLS AND INSTALLATION**

Tools Necessary: Allen Key (included). Flathead Screwdriver (not included). Note: To assemble product we recommend using two adults.

**NOTE:** When inserting bolts, turn clockwise until tight. Then loosen 1/2-3/4 of a turn. After crib is completely assembled, return to each bolt and tighten. Use wax or soap on all bolts to facilitate assembly. Page 2 of 16



**A WARNING:** Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.

•To reduce the risk of **SIDS**, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

#### Strangulation Hazard:

•Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. **DO NOT** suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.

•To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.

**DO NOT** place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

#### Fall Hazard:

•When child is able to pull to a standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.

■When child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 in. (90 cm), the crib shall no longer be used, and the child should be placed in a youth or regular bed.

Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact Bassett Furniture Industries, Inc. for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
 **DO NOT** use a water mattress with this crib.

If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

•Follow warnings on all products in a crib.

•Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.

Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.

## **CAUTION:** ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27-1/4 INCHES BY 51-5/8 INCHES WITH A THICKNESS NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES.

## WARNING

•Do not use this crib if the enclosed or attached instructions cannot be strictly adhered to. Do not use this crib if the child is able to climb out unaided or is taller than 90 cm. Do not place cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near this crib. Ensure that the sides are properly latched or locked in place when the crib is occupied. The mattress used with this crib should not be more than 15 cm thick and should be of such length and width that the gap between the mattress and the sides of the crib is not more than 3 cm when the mattress is pushed into the corner of the crib.

Parents should inspect the crib regularly -- before putting the child in the crib each day -- and confirm that every component of the crib is properly and securely in place.

## AWARNING: ENTRAPMENT/STRANGULATION HAZARD

Infants have died in toddler beds from entrapment and strangulation. Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.

NEVER use bed with children under 15 months.

NEVER place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

The mattress intended for use on the bed shall be a full-size crib mattress having minimum dimensions of 51-5/8 in. (1310 mm) in length, 27-1/4 in. (690 mm) in width and 4 in. (100 mm) in thickness, not exceeding 6 in. (152 mm) in thickness.


•If guardrails are used as the mattress containment means, guardrail(s) provided must be used to avoid the formation of a gap between the mattress and the bed that could cause an entrapment.

**DO NOT** place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

**DO NOT** place items with a string, cord, or ribbon around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.

**DO NOT** suspend strings over a toddler bed for any reason.


•A child using the toddler or day bed shall be at least 15 months of age and shall not weigh more than 50 lbs. (22.7 kgs.).






## STEP #1

LEFT & RIGHT SIDE FRAME AND HEADBOARD ASSEMBLY

#### Hardware needed for Step #1:

(AA) Allen Wrench (1 piece)(BB) 1-3/4 in. Bolts (x 4 pieces)



### **STEP #2** STRETCHER BAR ASSEMBLY


#### Stretcher Bar (x 1)

Insert barrel nuts into holes in stretcher bar
Align threaded hole in barrel nut with bolt (CC)
NOTE: Slot on barrel nut (DD) faces outward

•NOTE: Do not fully tighten at this time.

(AA) Allen Wrench (1 piece)(CC) 2-1/2 in. Bolts (x 2 pieces)(DD) K.D. Barrel Nuts (x 2 pieces)


FOOTBOARD ASSEMBLY

(AA) Allen Wrench (1 piece) (BB) 1-3/4 in. Bolts (x 4 pieces)

#### Mattress Support (x 1)

(AA) Allen Wrench (1 piece)(EE) Filler Bolts (x 16 pieces)





#### Hardware needed for Step #6:

(AA) Allen Wrench (1 piece) (BB) 1-3/4 in. Bolts (x 8 pieces) (EE) Filler Bolts (x 12 pieces)

NOTE: Insert 1 (EE) bolt into every remaining hole, after mattress support is in place.



### **STEP #7** FULL SIZE BED INSTRUCTIONS


Full size bed rails (x 1 pair) (Sold separately)

#### Hardware needed for Step #7:

(AA) Allen wrench (1 piece)(EE) Filler bolts (x 4 pieces)

## Note: (EE) Filler bolts & Hardware included with bed rails

From the crib, detach all bolts from the footboard. Then detach all bolts from the headboard. Insert (2) (EE) filler bolts in top holes of headboard & footboard & tighten to snug fit. To attach bed rail, insert (2) machine bolts with lock washer & flat washer through holes in side rails into bushings in headboard and tighten with allen wrench. Repeat this procedure on all four areas for proper full-size bed hook-up.



IMPORTANT: Store away all extra parts to this "crib", "toddler bed", that you are not using for possible future use, as you may wish to convert again. Always store the assembly directions in the pouch attached to the mattress support.
