In 1844 he involved the Duke in an awkward situation when Meynell 'sent for a woman' at an inn in Derby, to which the innkeeper took offence. Meynell called the innkeeper a fool, and the Duke intervened to resolve the dispute. He was finally dismissed in 1851 when it was discovered that he was in a brothel in London while in possession of the Duke's dog Vio. Paxton went to find him and demanded that he return the dog. The Duke then reluctantly dismissed him and forbade him from returning to any of his houses, although he did give Meynell a generous pension.
