ŠRI SARASWATI

Šri Saraswati is the *śakti* or the power or energy behind Lord *Brahma*, the Creator. She is the embodiment of the Divine Mother in Her manifestation as the Goddess of Learning. She enables Her votaries to pursue and achieve the goal of life, i.e. Self-Realization. She is the presiding Deity of all branches of knowledge and is variously known as *Sakala Kalā Vāni*, *Vidyā Swarupini*, *Vāk Devi* etc. all of which convey Her most prominent attribute as the Goddess who confers on her devotees, felicity with words or skills for realizing the Supreme Knowledge, the goal of human life.

Out of an infinite number of species in the universe, the Divine Mother has bestowed the ability to speak on human beings only, with the specific objective of enabling them to acquire the Supreme Knowledge by properly utilizing words. Accordingly, those blessed souls who have an understanding of the purpose of this special Divine gift, are inclined to utilize words, both spoken and written, in furtherance of this goal only. Out of these *mahātmas* (great souls) a chosen few like *Mooka Kavi* or *Kāidasa* or *Ādi Śankara* etc. receive Her blessings in full measure and compose beautiful and profound poems, by reading which the entire humanity is benefited.

Šri Saraswati is usually depicted with four arms, seated on a *hamsa* (swan), clad in a white garment, carrying *aksha māla* and *pustaka* (book) respectively in two arms and holding a *veena* by the other two arms. Her white garment stands for purity and those blessed by Her will have crystal clear intellect enabling them to easily gain the Supreme Knowledge. Each letter of the alphabet denotes a distinct sound and *Aksha Māla* or 'garland of letters' is made of all individual letters in the alphabet. This garland signifies that She resides in each letter or sound denoted by it. The *pustaka* (book) in Her hand symbolically represents the collection of all words made out of these letters and sounds. Among all the musical instruments, the music generated by *Veena*, is considered supreme.

Her two *vāhanas* (vehicles) are a swan and a peacock. The swan symbolizes *viveka* or discrimination (between reality and unreality) because of its ability to separate pure milk from water. Similarly, a peacock represents the multifarious sense-attractions in this world and by riding a peacock Šri Saraswati shows us that we should have complete mastery over our senses and its attractions.

The ninth and last day of *Devi Navarātri* is a special day for the worship of Šri Saraswati. This day is also known as *Āyudha Pooja* Day. On this day devotees place in the altar books or other instruments of their respective occupations or livelihood and worship Šri Saraswati, invoking Her in the books or instruments placed in the altar and seeking Her blessings.

On the following day (*Vijaya Daśami*), after worshipping the books or instruments once again, devotees remove those from the altar and re-commence their pursuit of Knowledge in their respective fields. *Vijaya Daśami* Day is considered very auspicious for *Vidyārambham* or initiating children to learning and Šri Saraswati is sure to lead those children to victory and success.

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO THE TEMPLE

By Automobile: (A) If you are driving **from Manhattan or points West**, take I-495 East (Long Island Expressway) to Exit 24 (Kissena Blvd) and turn **LEFT** at Kissena Blvd.

(B) If you are driving **from Long Island or points East**, take I-495 West (Long Island Expressway) to Exit 24 (Kissena Blvd) and turn **RIGHT** at Kissena Blvd.

Drive about a mile on Kissena Blvd and turn **RIGHT** into Holly Avenue. Drive 3 blocks on Holly Avenue to Bowne Street. The Temple is on the **LEFT** side.

(C) If you are driving **from Connecticut or points North**, take I-95 South to I-678 South (Van Wyck Expressway). After crossing Whitestone Bridge, stay on I-678 South (**RIGHT** lane) and take Exit 15 to 20th Ave. At the traffic light, turn **LEFT** into Parsons Blvd and drive about 2.5 miles. At Flushing Hospital Medical Center (on **RIGHT**), turn **RIGHT** into 45th Ave and drive to next block. At Smart Street, turn **LEFT** and drive to the end of the street to Temple Parking Lot behind the temple.

(D) If you are driving **from Princeton, Philadelphia or points South**, take I-278 via Staten Island and take Exit 35 to I-495 East (Long Island Expressway) and follow directions as above (A).

By Public Transportation: Take Subway **Train No. 7** from Times Square to Flushing Main Street (the last stop on 7 train). Then take MTA **Bus Q27** from Main Street to Bowne Street on Holly Avenue. The bus runs on Kissena Blvd and turns left into Holly Ave Bus Stop. The next stop is Bowne Street near the temple. The bus ride is about 5 to 10 minutes. You may also take MTA **Buses Q17, Q25 and Q34** to Kissena Blvd and Holly Avenue and walk two short blocks to the temple.

Long Island Rail Road (**LIRR**) Trains from Penn Station / Woodside to Port Washington also stop in Flushing Main Street, adjacent to 7 train.
