Willy Pinnem has been refereeing matches for the IWA since the 90s and he's seen it all, but when he sees some of the rookies struggling to score about a 490 in their ring performance scores, well he needs to speak up.

First off, have you watched the How to Win in the IWA video on YouTube? If not, go watch it and then come back and finish reading this. It's barely 20 minutes that can turn your title-less woes into 'what am I gonna do with all this gold baby?' Did you watch it? Okay, then read on.

To keep things simple and easy to digest, the highest score you can get is a 501, but a 495 or higher will net your wrestler a "*" and very likely, a spot on the title page. If you want to win, you need to pay attention and there is a lot of help out here. From the How to Win in the IWA video, other players and the IWAR Gold Strategy Workshop that is held a few days before your Matches, Trash Talk and Strategy changes are due in to the IWA by email the Monday before Gold runs the next day. So do you wanna win or not?

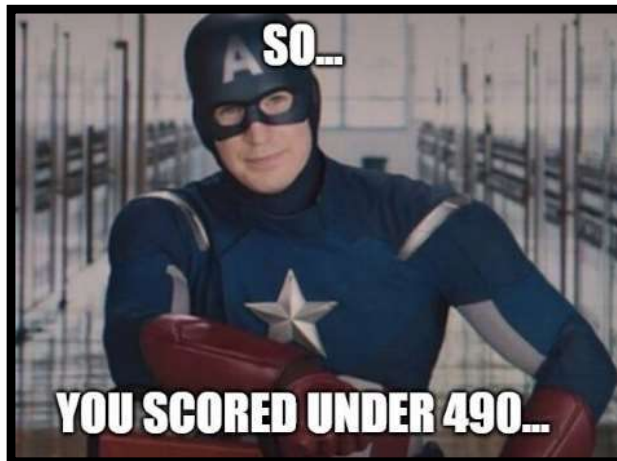
CHANGE YOUR STRATS

The value of the holds change every cycle, so if you want to win, you'll need to change with them or you will scores will drop. The values for the holds in the current cycle are included in the bulletin. You can use their values to create your wrestler's strategy

What we have here is a basic approach using the holds from the previous cycle's scores that were worth 25pts (*they always go up in value*), both 30s (*they are never worth less than 26pts*) and then a mix of the others. [Ignore the holds worth less than 25pts or 41pts.]

For the 11-15 holds, use both holds worth 45pts and pick one from the 41s as they always go up like the 25s do.

This will get you started, but you need to use the advice on the right to sharpen those skills to score higher.

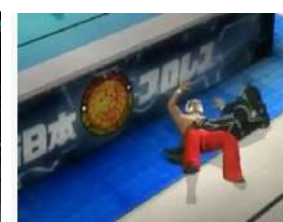
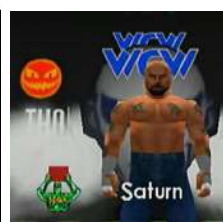

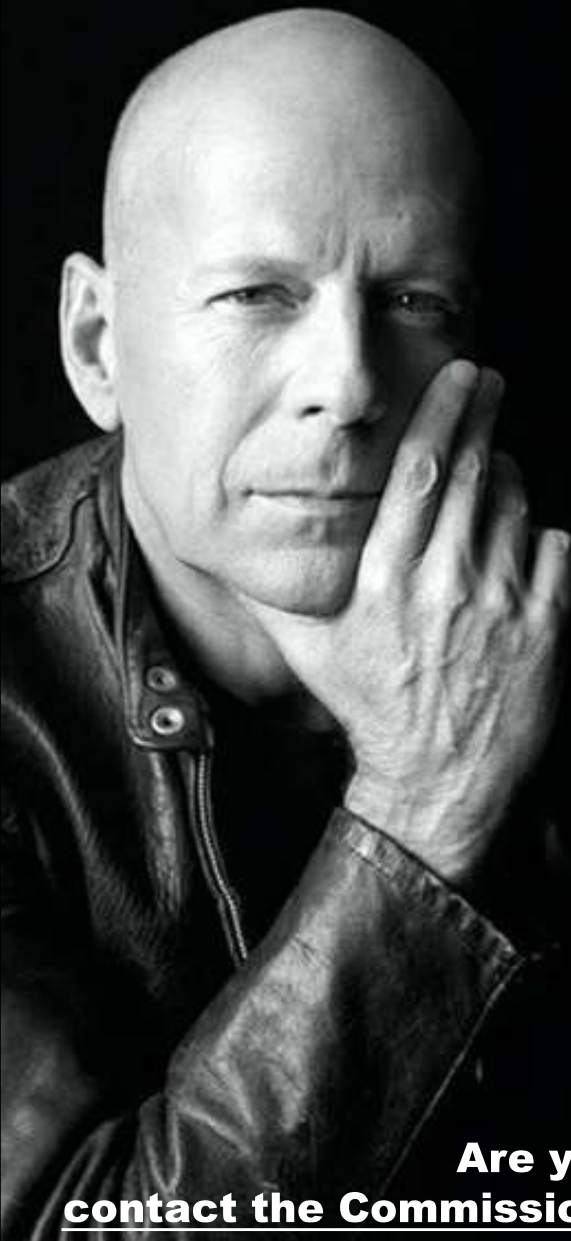

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the IWAR Network?

Back in 2012, the IWAR Network (then called the Gold Rush Report) formed in order to supply an atmosphere for the creative style of play to thrive. This led to an IWA Revolution that raised the level of play and the result has been a steady stream of IWAR superstars having changed the game. While the size of the IWAR has fluctuated, the talent has not and it now consists of the Battle Royal League (BRL), Independent Wrestling League (IWL) and the National Wrestling League (NWL). The IWAR World champions face the #1 contender (top ranked Commissioner Champion from the three veteran leagues) every four cycles in an interleague Triple Threat match. While the leagues share certain similarities, they are also very much their own entity and have an atmosphere and environment unique to their managers and commissioner.

Why are new IWA players only allowed to stay 16 cycles in the NWL?

New and some returning players get to play against others who are on the same level as they learn all aspects of the game. After 16 cycles (not including their 10-0 exhibition debut, when everyone is terrible) we believe they should move on to the IWA at large.

How do I get my wrestler onto a pay per view show or on the cover of the IWA Ringside Magazine?

Be active, trash talk (make a challenge), and confirm your interest with your commissioner to make sure they are aware.

How do I become a Commissioner in the IWA?

Find a league without a commissioner and ask the IWA about taking on the job. In my experience, just about any commissioner is happy to have a co-commissioner join the team and it's also a great way to identify the person they can pass the torch to when then look to step down someday. So much work comes with the position, and much of it is unsung, so it is important to be reliable and take the time to meet and network with other players to build a core group that will support your league.

Who can challenge for the IWAR World championship?

The IWAR World champion faces the #1 contender among the commissioner's champions from the IWAR's veteran leagues: the BRL, CWL, and IWL who has the highest three cycle strategy average. They engage in a 3 cycle series to determine who will be the champion. Once the series concludes, they face a new #1 contender (cannot be the same wrestler).

Who can challenge for their IWAR league's Commissioner's Championship?

- BRL:** The Commissioner selects a group of wrestlers based on their promos into qualifying matches where the winners will earn a title shot at the Global, North American or Cruiserweight championships on next pay per view event. These matches are held at every ppv so if your wrestler misses out they could get a shot in the future if they talk up the title or champion and why they deserve a shot.
- IWL:** The IWL Heavyweight, Pan-American and Grand Prix Champions defend against IWL pay-per-view event or tournament winners. The IWC Tag Team Champions face the winner of the 4-Pack Challenge, the Pan Am Champion defends against the winner of a special event and the challenger for the Grand Prix title is determined by the champion.
- NWL:** The New Wave League's Young Lions champion defends the title in a Triple Threat match against the winner of a Fatal Four Way #1 Contenders match that is made up of four of the top wrestlers who have displayed exceptional promo skills and the third spot goes to the winner of the most recent Willowick Classic. The Hardcore champion defends the title against the winner of a Ladder match which features a group of wrestlers who've earned that spot.
- IWAR:** The IWAR championships are the top titles in the IWAR and are defended like this;
 - Every four cycles, the IWAR World Champions (singles, tag team and six-man) defends the title against the BRL's Global champ and the IWL's Heavyweight champs.
 - The Revolution champion defends against the BRL's North American and IWL's Pan Am champions every four cycles, but they also defend the title against the winners of IWAR special events and contests.

I won Free matches and/or credit from an IWAR event/contest, how do I redeem them?

When you send in your IWA matches, make note of the prize you won and how so the IWA knows you earned them. (This is a good idea for any free matches or credit you earn in the IWA.)

I'd like to take a break from the IWA, but I don't want to lose my wrestler's stats?


The IWA will 'store' your wrestler with their record and all of their earnings and stars in the "Grave Yard" for \$2.00 per wrestler and you can retrieve them (for free) when you are ready to return.
