## PACKET 1

### **USCIS Form I-485 Application for Adjustment of Status (Green Card)**

- This forms is <u>required</u> and needs to be completed for each applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents – spouses/children)
- Filing fee:
  - \$1,225 for each applicant age 14 and older
  - \$750 for each applicant under the age of 14
  - Payment must be a check or money order made payable to: U.S.
     Department of Homeland Security
  - NOTE: you will need to issue a check/money order for each applicant – do not combine the filing fees into one check
- Primary Applicant:
  - Two identical passport photographs for each applicant with name and date of birth written in pencil on back (add A# if available)
  - Employment verification letter verifying the principle alien's salary and permanent full time employment
  - Copy of latest IRS tax return and W-2
  - I-485 Supplement J form (if you are filing the I-485 separately from the I-140 application)
- Dependents (Spouse/Children):
  - Two identical passport photographs for each applicant with name and date of birth written in pencil on back (add A# if available)
  - Copy of marriage and/or birth certificates
  - Form I-134 Affidavit of Support
    - Filing fee: No additional filing fee is required to file this form



- Complete this form for each dependent (spouse and/or children) who is/are filing form I-485 as well
- Employment verification letter verifying the principle alien's salary and permanent full time employment

## **PACKET 2** (Complete for each I-485 applicant)

## A. USCIS Form G-325A Biographic Information

- Filing fee: No additional fee is required to file this form
- This form is <u>required</u> and needs to be completed for each I-485 applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents – spouses/children 14 years and older)
- Copy of birth certificate for each applicant
  - o If other than English, a notarized translation is required as well

### B. USCIS Form I-693 Medical Examination

- Filing fee: No additional fee is required to file this form, however, you will need to pay a fee for the medical examination itself. The fee is determined by the civil surgeon's office which you select for the examination (see note below)
- This form is <u>required</u> and must be completed for <u>each</u> I-485 applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents – spouses/children)
- NOTE: Medical examinations can only be conducted by USCIS approved civil surgeons. Please use the website below to locate civil surgeons in your vicinity:

- Proof that each applicant maintained valid status during entire period of any U.S. stay (evidence includes Forms I-797A Notice of Action, I-20s, DS-2019, waiver of J-1 home residency, U.S. entry stamps in passport as



acquired at the U.S. , U.S. visa stickers as acquired at U.S. embassy abroad etc.)

### **D. Signed Authenticity Statement**

Provide this for each I-485 applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents

 spouses/children)



## Packet 4 (optional)

## A. <u>USCIS Form I-765 Employment Authorization Card</u>

- Filing fee: No additional fee is required to file this form
- This form is <u>optional</u> and may be filed together with form I-485 or at a later time by using the I-485 verification receipt notice
- Complete this form for each I-485 applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents – spouses/children)
- Supporting documentation:
  - Two photographs with applicant's name and date of birth written in pencil on back. (add A# if available)
  - Copy of previously held EAD authorizations (i.e., F-1/OPT Card)

## B. <u>USCIS Form I-131 Advance Parole</u>

- Filing fee: No additional fee is required to file this form
- This form is <u>optional</u> and may be filed together with form I-485 or at a later time by using the I-485 verification receipt notice
- Complete this form for each I-485 applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents – spouses/children)
- Supporting documentation:
  - Two photographs with applicant's name and date of birth written in pencil on back. (add A# if available)

#### **IMPORTANT**

Once you have received the I-485 receipt notice and/or the Green Card, be sure to forward copies of these documents to our office.



## **Non-concurrent Filing**

In the event that you file the I-485 separately from the I-140 (non-concurrent filing) include the following:

# **USCIS I-140 Receipt Notice or I-140 Approval Notice**

- Required if you are filing the adjustment of status application(s) after our office has already filed the I-140 petition with USCIS
- Include a copy of either the I-140 receipt notice (if the I-140 is still pending with USCIS) or the I-140 approval notice
- Provide this for each I-485 applicant (primary beneficiary and dependents

   spouses/children)
