# FROM OUR ASSOCIATE PASTOR



Many people have said they've enjoyed being able to participate in parish events that are livestreamed, most especially Mass. Some have been wondering what more they can do to be united in prayer with the Church during this time, in a way even more real than watching Mass virtually. One such idea I've seen tossed around is the Divine Office.

The Divine Office, also known as the Breviary or Liturgy of the Hours, is, next to the Mass, the most important prayer of the Church. Taking to heart St. Paul's exhortation to "pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18), the Church gives a series of psalms, scriptural canticles, and readings to be done at different points during the day. Vatican II's document on the liturgy stated, "the divine office is devised so that the whole course of the day and night is made holy by the praises of God." (Sacrosanctum Concilium 84). As such, the Breviary is split up into five parts: the Office of Readings, which may be done at any point during the day; Morning Prayer, Daytime Prayer, Evening Prayer, and Night Prayer which are prayed at the appropriate times. While the breviary is primarily prayed by priests, deacons, and religious, Vatican II called for a restoration of the breviary to truly being the prayer of the entire Church, and exhorted laypeople to join as well. Praving the breviary is a good way to sanctify your whole day and unite yourself with the hundreds of thousands of others in the Church who pray it.

How can you get started? There is an excellent free app for both <u>iPhones</u> and <u>Androids</u> called "iBreviary" that automatically downloads the prayers for each day. If you prefer a physical book, there is one called "Shorter Christian Prayer" which contains the main hours – Morning, Evening, and Night Prayer – in an easy to use format. This is available from Amazon as well as local Catholic bookstores.

All in all, if you've found yourself longing for more time with Our Lord in your life, consider adding the Divine Office to your daily regimen. It's an easy thing to schedule in and helps refocus yourself on God throughout the day. If you have any questions, feel free to call or email me!

# **RESPECT LIFE**

The Supreme Court of the United States announced its decision in an abortion case out of Louisiana, June Medical Services v. Russo. The Court ruled 5 to 4 to strike down the Louisiana law that requires abortion doctors to have hospital admitting privileges. Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City in Kansas and chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Committee for Pro-Life Activities issued the following statement:

"Abortion violently ends the life of a child, and often severely harms women. Abortion becomes even more destructive when basic health and safety standards are ignored, and profit margins are prioritized over women's lives. As Catholics, we condemn abortion as a grave injustice that denies the fundamental human right to life. Yet even as we seek to end the brutality of legalized abortion, we still believe that the women who seek it should not be further harmed and abused by a callous, profit-driven industry."

"The Court's failure to recognize the legitimacy of laws prioritizing women's health and safety over abortion business interests continues a cruel precedent. As we grieve this decision and the pregnant women who will be harmed by it, we continue to pray and fight for justice for mothers and children."
