#### Marriage:

The policy of the Diocese of Metuchen asks that arrangements be made one year in advance. Engaged couples should make an appointment to meet with the Priest at the rectory to determine a date for the marriage and have it officially registered.

#### Baptism:

Arrangements are to be made in advance. Parents are to attend one pre-Baptism class, held every first Wednesday of the month. Reservations for the class should be made by calling the Parish Office at least a week in advance of the class. Godparents must have a letter indicating they are Catholics in good standing. One non-Catholic may be accepted as a Christian witness. Baptisms are celebrated on the Second Sunday of each Month at the 1:00pm Ceremony.

#### Anointing of the Sick:

For those of advanced age and those seriously ill, contact the Rectory.

#### Holy Hour:

First Friday of Every Month from 7 - 8 pm

#### St. Peregrine Mass:

Mass in honor of St. Peregrine, takes place on the 2nd Wednesday of the month at 7 PM. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is administered to all the sick during the Mass. Prayer cards and medals of St. Peregrine are also available.

#### Policy for Certificates of Eligibility:

In order to receive a Certificate of Eligibility to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, you must be a practicing Catholic. One of the main aspects of a practicing Catholic is regular attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. The only way we can confirm such attendance is by use of envelopes. Please be sure to use your Church Envelopes to avoid problems or embarrassment in the future.

## From the Pastor's Desk

On Sunday, September 22, 2019, I will become the sixth pastor of Blessed Sacrament Church. I wish to acknowledge the legacy of the admirable pastors that have served the parish: Fr. Russo, Fr. Macdonald, Msgr. Kennedy, Msgr. Prus and most recently, Fr. Rusk. Each pastor brought their particular gifts to Blessed Sacrament. I hope that I will be able to provide for the people of Blessed Sacrament a tangible manifestation of God's grace.

Last May, Msgr. John Fell asked a simple question to the parishioners of St. Mary's-Stony Hill, "*how has Fr. Brian led the congregation to Jesus Christ?*" I was surprised that it would be the first question to be asked. However, upon reflection, it was the right question to be asked. It was a powerful reminder to me that my primary role as a pastor is to aid people in their relationship with Jesus Christ. And that mandate must always be on my mind and in my heart.

The life of a parish priest is made up of mundane chores and moments of extraordinary privilege. The ordinary: bills, buildings, budgets, diocesan expectations, to mention a few items that occupy the time and minds of pastors. The moments of grace become beautiful when we are leading someone to Christ in a visible way: sacramental moments: the morning of a funeral, or running into someone and they can speak about what is happening in their life.

Pope Francis has made accompaniment a consistent pastoral theme of significant importance in his pontificate, especially when speaking to pastors. As he reminded the bishops of Brazil at World Youth Day in 2013,

[W]e need a church capable of walking at people's side, of doing more than simply listening to them; a church that accompanies them on their journey; a church able to make sense of the "night" contained in the flight of so many of our brothers and sisters from Jerusalem; a church that realizes that the reasons why people leave also contain reasons why they can eventually return. But we need to know how to interpret, with courage, the larger picture. Jesus warmed the hearts of the disciples of Emmaus.

As I officially assume the duties of pastor of Blessed Sacrament, I pray for the grace and wisdom to accompany you in our journey pilgrimage. There will be moments of routine and time of blessings in our expanding relationship with Jesus Christ. As Georges Bernanos said in his classic Catholic novel, *The Diary of a County Priest*, "all is grace." Let us welcome graces yet to be received.
