#### Today's Liturgy

When God created men and women, he blessed them with great gifts and gave them the authority to manage everything that God has created. He also gave men the understanding to comply with necessary regulations and rules to carry out his work.

We know that from the beginning of creation there is an adversary, who is also known as the ancient snake or devil. This enemy began his task from the garden of Eden trying to take away from men his dignity as children of God. Since then he has wanted to destroy the plan of God, causing man to depart from his father, being unfaithful to his commands and listening to his false accusations.

It should be noted in this passage from the Gospel of Saint Luke, this man who probably had been faithful in the administration of his master's business was seduced by the Evil one, and began to squander his property reaching such an extent that his own companion betrayed his fraudulent conduct, thus causing his outrage of his master who later asked for accounts of his administration.

It is then, that he uses cunning in front of debtors who would later assure him that they would pity him when he lost the position entrusted to him. This is why the Sacred Scriptures advises us that we cannot follow two masters, for we will love one and hate the other. This parable teaches us that we must be faithful in the little to deserve the imperishable goods.




