



Fast Lane Support

- Best QoS configuration globally
 - Platinum QoS profile with WMM
 - Expedited bandwidth
 - DSCP is trusted upstream
- Admin provisions iOS devices with a QoS profile
- Admin whitelists Jabber to get QoS marking (via MAM or Apple Configurator)
- Cisco WLC 8.3 or later
- Apple iOS 10 or later

Jabber Media Assure Support

With Media Assure, Jabber will be able to:

- Temporarily limit bandwidth on streams
- Re-sync video
- Pace packets to avoid unnecessary congestion based burst losses
- Provide resilience mechanisms by using upfront SDP signaling from first media packet
- Protect packet loss using Reed-Solomon FEC (RS FEC)
- Avoid congestion based loss because of over production of media
- Improve protection of low frame rate / low bit rate streams
- Support authenticated and encrypted FEC



Better network adaptation
More resilient to packet loss
Best voice/video quality





Jabber Media Assure Support

Video with 20% Packet loss, with and without Media Assure







Requirements for Media Assure

- Unified CM 11.5 or later to fully support Media Assure
 - Unified CM 10.0 implemented Media Assure requirements except RS FEC (Reed-Solomon FEC) for audio
 - RS FEC audio was implemented in Unified CM 11.5
- In Unified CM, the following must be configured:
 - SDP Transparency Profile in device's SIP Profile
 - The profile set to Pass all unknown SDP attributes
- Expressway (or VCS) X8.8.1 or later
- Jabber 11.8 or later
 - <EnableMari> in jabber-config.xml (default set to true)







Cisco Directory Integration

- Jabber 11.8 introduces a new LDAP Integration
 - Replaces EDI/BDI Configuration
 - Cross Platform common configuration
 - Cross platform DNS LDAP discovery
 - GSSAPI Authentication on Desktop

EDI Configuration settings now used across all platforms.








New Emoticons and behaviours

Unicode Emoji Support




- Unicode Consortium have defined a standard characters for exchanging emoji
- This allows cross platform emoji exchange
- All Jabber 11.8 platforms now support Unicode Emoji in addition to Emoticons
- Emoji are selected using OS tools on each platform

- Cisco Prime Collaboration Assurance




E911 Warning Popup





Notifications

- Chat messages
 - Notifications fade automatically
 - Notifications stay on screen until dismissed
 - New option to disable notification time out
 - Notification displayed until user dismisses
 - Alignment with MacOS




Enhanced Contact Import

- Import contacts using vCard and CSV file formats








Disable Voice in User Interface





Apple Push Notification Support

Future iOS release:


- Jabber to no longer run in background for an extended period
- Jabber terminated if not running in foreground after some time


APNS:

- Support released in two phases
- Upgrade UC Environment before September 2017
- Failure to upgrade will result in loss of voice, video and IM notifications

Call to Action:


- Phase 1: Support for IM&P- CUCM11.5(1)SU2, Expressway
 8.9, Jabber 11.8.1. PLAN NOW TO UPGRADE!
- Phase 2: Support for Voice/Video calls CUCM 11.5(1)SU3, Expressway 8.10, Jabber 11.9
- Cisco Communications Manager to register and stay connected to Cisco Collaboration Cloud
- iPhone / iPad to connect to Apple Cloud / APN service







Some Answers for common questions...



Servers will tell
Jabber on start-up
if PUSH has
been enabled



Jabber will be suspended and terminated when put in background



An APNs notification will wake OR start

Jabber running.

(Jabber will then login to UC Service)



Chat messages carried in APNs payload are encrypted



What I will need to do?



- CUCM, IM&P will require upgrades to 11.5(1) SU2 for IM, SU3 for calls
- CUCM Cluster will require registration to Cisco collaboration cloud (direct / proxy / expressway)
- 3. Firewall ACLs may require modification
- Expressway will require an upgrade to 8.9.1 (IM) or 8.10 (calls) if using Mobile Remote Access
- 5. Jabber will require upgrading to 11.8.1 (IM) or 11.9 (voice & video)
- 6. If using SSO with iOS upgrade to 11.5 but wait for SU3 before turning on Push. (i.e. oAuth)


Communication with the cloud UC Manager connection to Cloud



Registration creates a token which is distributed to all nodes in cluster

This token allows all nodes to send APNs request to Cisco cloud.







CUCM must be able to connect Cisco cloud




How the Quad Camera works




