## What is the Integrated Delivery System?

The Integrated Delivery System (IDS) functions as the action arm of the CAIB and develops a comprehensive, coordinated plan for integrating and implementing community outreach and prevention programs (e.g., financial management; violence awareness, intervention, and prevention; health promotion; tobacco cessation, etc.). The IDS improves the delivery of human service programs by establishing a seamless system of services through collaborative partnerships and coordinated activities.

The IDS prepares a base Community Action Plan at least every two years to guide the activities of the IDS, CAIB, and member organizations using the results of AF community needs assessments and other available data
