I. Introduction

The Sprint Cloud Binder app is available for Android phones/tablets and iPhones/iPads. Sprint Cloud Binder is an app that allows people to connect cloud storage accounts and view/access their content.

II. Launch the Sprint Cloud Binder App

This section explains how to access, install and launch the Sprint Cloud Binder the first time via the VPL app.

On Android devices, the Sprint Cloud Binder app is pre-loaded onto many Sprint devices and the app icon appears on the mobile phone in the app tray. If your device does not have the Sprint Cloud Binder app pre-loaded, you can open the Play Store app and install the Sprint Cloud Binder app form the store.

If your device is an iPhone or iPad, you can open the Apple App Store and install the Sprint Cloud Binder app form the App Store.

- Tap the Sprint Cloud Binder app icon.
- 2. An introductory screen appears with a button to install the app.
- 3. Tap the button.
- On Android devices: The phone will open the Google Play Store application.
 On iOS devices: The phone will open the Apple App Store application.
- 5. Search the store for 'Sprint Cloud Binder'.
- 6. Install or update the application.
- 7. When the installation is complete the **Sprint Cloud Binder** app icon will appear in the list of apps on your mobile device home screen or apps tray.

You are now ready to begin using the Sprint Cloud Binder app.



III. Get Started

1. Initial Setup Wizard

This section explains the screens seen the first time when entering the app.

When the app is installed for the first time, the tutorial screens appear. You are then prompted to select your cloud drive(s).


- 1. Launch the **Sprint Cloud Binder** app.
- 2. Scroll through the app's tutorial and tap **Skip** or **Get Started/Continue**.

Tap Agree and continue on the EULA acceptance screen to continue.
 If Decline is selected, the app automatically closes. Agree and continue must be selected in order to continue the initial setup.

2. Add/Remove a Cloud Drive

This section explains how to add or remove a cloud drive account to the app.

Adding or removing a cloud drive account to the app requires that you follow the steps below. Multiple accounts from each supported cloud drive service can be added to the **Sprint Cloud Binder** app.

ADD A CLOUD DRIVE

- 1. Tap Add a drive.
 - a. On first time app launch:



Tap the Add a drive button on the Get Started screen.

b. On regular app launch:



Tap the My Drives button from the Home screen and tap the Add a drive button.


- 2. The **Add a Cloud Drive** screen opens showing the list of cloud drives.
 - Tap on one of the cloud drives in the list.
- 3. The Add Account screen appears.


Note: On the iOS Cloud Drives and Android Amazon Drive only this screen does not appear.


- a. Tap **Existing** and follow the prompts to sign in to an existing account.
- b. Tap **New** and follow the prompts to create a new account.



- 4. After signing in to the selected drive successfully, the **Drive Info** screen appears displaying the free space indicator, account name and account description. Tap to edit account **Description** field.
 - a. Tap **Save** to add the selected cloud drive to the app. The **Home** screen then appears.
 - b. Tap **Save + Add another drive** to add the selected cloud drive to the app and return to the **Add a Cloud drive** screen.
- 5. After selecting **Save**, the next screen that appears is the **Home** screen.

EDIT OR REMOVE A CLOUD DRIVE

After adding a drive or additional drives to the Sprint Cloud Binder, the list of drives can be seen in the **My Drives** screen. Each drive can be edited or removed.

1. From the **Home** screen tap **My Drives**.




- 2. The My Drives screen opens.
 - a. Short tap on a cloud drive in the list to open the **Drive Info** screen.
 - Short tap on a cloud drive and the details of the drive account are displayed.
 - The account description can be edited by tapping in the **Description** field.
 - Tap **Save** to save any changes made and return to the **My Drives** screen.
 - b. From the **My Drives** screen, you can select and account to remove it from the app. Long tap (Android) or swipe left (iOS) on a cloud drive.

The **Remove Drive** option appears.


Tap on **Remove Drive**. Two options appear – YES, NO.

- Tap YES to remove the selected drive.
 On Android: A window appears with the confirmation that the drive has been removed successfully. Tap OK.
- Tap **NO** to exit the window without removing the selected cloud drive.

TOP BAR: OPTIONS

The following options appear on the top bar of the My Drives and Add a Cloud Drive screens:

← BACK:

Once you have added your desired Cloud Drives, tapping the **Back** button from the **Add a Cloud Drive** and **Drive Info** screens goes to the **Home** screen.

Note: on iOS, tapping the Back button from the Drive Info screen returns you to the My Drives screen.



Tap the **Menu** icon to open the following list of options:

- **Upload:** Tap **Upload** to select a file or files to upload then select the Cloud Drive (as per the list of cloud drives you have already added) to upload it to.
- **Settings**: Tap **Settings** to open the **Settings** screen with the list of app settings. See the 'Settings' section for more information.

② HELP:

Tap the **Help** icon to open and the online help.

Q SEARCH:

Tap the **Search** icon to open the search field.



IV. Home Screen

> This section explains the Home screen functions.

The **Home** screen is the entry point into all the main functions of the app.



Home screen



Photos:

Tap Photos to view a combined list of the photos on all added cloud drive accounts and to use all the functions available for photos.



Tap Music to view a combined list of the music on all added cloud drive accounts and to use all the functions available for music.



Tap Videos to view a combined list of the videos on all added cloud drive accounts and to use all the functions available for videos.



Documents:

Tap **Documents** to view a combined list of the documents on all added cloud drive accounts and to use all the functions available for documents.





Tap **Folders** to view the folders and files on all added cloud drive accounts and to use all the functions available for folders and files.



Favorites:

Tap **Favorites** to view the combined list of your photos, music, videos and documents that have been designated as "favorite files". A file designated as a favorite file will be stored locally and appear in the **Favorites** view. A Favorites icon will also appear on that file in all other media views. Tap **Favorites** to see the combined list of favorite files in the cloud drive accounts and to use all the functions available for them.

Total Available Storage:

The total available storage is displayed. This shows the combined total available and used space of all of the cloud drive accounts that are currently signed into the app.

TOP BAR: OPTIONS



Tap the **Menu** icon to open the following list of options:

- Refresh Content: Tap Refresh Content to refresh the screen information.
- **Settings:** Tap **Settings** to open the **Settings** screen with the list of app settings. See the 'Settings' section for more information.

? Help:

Tap the **Help** icon to open and the online help.

Q Search:

Tap the **Search** icon to open the search field.



V. Top Bar: Options





1. Photos Views: List View, Thumbs View & Timeline View

This section explains about the main **Photos** views.



Android: Photos View Tabs

Tap **Photos** on the **Home** screen. The **Photos** screen with the following view options appears.

LIST VIEW

Tap the **List** tab on the **Photos** screen to view a list of the photos on the connected cloud drive accounts. Each file appears with the file name and thumbnail.

THUMBS VIEW

Tap the **Thumbs** tab on the **Photos** screen to view thumbnail images of the photos on your cloud drive accounts.

Note: After tapping **Photos** from the Home screen, the Thumbs view appears by default.

TIMELINE VIEW

Tap the **Timeline** tab on the **Photos** screen to navigate through the photos in your cloud drive accounts sorted by years, months or days, based on the date the file was created on the cloud.

VIEWING OPTIONS:



Cloud Drive File Source:

Each file appears with a small icon indicating its cloud drive source.

• Filter by drive:

Select the **Filter by drive** menu option and then choose the options you want from the cloud drives list. Only the files on the selected drives will display on the screen. This filter will reset automatically when you leave the Photo view screen and return to the **Home** screen.

Sort by:

Select the **Sort by** menu option (not available on the Timeline view) and then choose to sort by file name, date or file type. The files will display sorted by file name, date or file type. This filter will reset automatically when you leave the Video view and return to the Home screen.

Refresh Content:

Select the **Refresh Content** menu option to refresh the content being viewed.

Full Size View:

Tap on a photo to view it in **Full Size** view.



2. Photos: Full Size View

- This section explains about the Photos Full Size view.
- 1. Tap **Photos** on the **Home** screen.
- 2. Tap the **List**, **Thumbs** or **Timeline** tab.
- 3. Tap on a photo to select and view it in **Full Size** view.
- 4. Tap or pinch to Zoom In or Zoom Out of the photo.
- 5. Scroll right or left to view the next or previous photo in the list.
- 6. The bottom bar displays a list of the photo options (for more information see the 'Photo Options' section).
- 7. Tap **Back** to exit the **Full Size** view and return to the previous screen.

3. Selection Mode: Select Files

Open the selection mode to select multiple files.

- On Android: Long tap on one file to select that file and open the selection mode. Tap on other
 files to select additional files. Each selected file appears with a check mark. The number of
 selected files appears on the top of the screen. Tap 'X' to deselect the files and exit the
 selection mode.
- On iOS: Tap the Select menu option to open the selection mode and select multiple files. The number of selected files appears on the top of the screen. Tap Cancel to exit the selection mode
- 3. The bottom bar displays a list of the photo options (for more information see the 'Photo Options' section).

This section lists the options available for photos.

The photo options appear on the bottom bar in the **Selection Mode** or in the **Full Size** view.



DELETE



Delete file(s).

- 1. Select file(s) from your cloud drives.
- 2. Select the **Delete** option (not available for local My Device files).
- 3. Confirm deletion.'

DOWNLOAD



Download photos from your cloud drives to your mobile device.

- 1. Select file(s) from your cloud drives.
- 2. Select the **Download** option (not available for local My Device files).
- 3. The file(s) are downloaded to your mobile device.

MOVE



Move the selected photo(s) from one cloud drive to another.

- Select file(s) from your cloud drives.
- 2. Select the Move option (not available for local My Device files).
- 3. Select a cloud drive to move the selected file(s) to it.
- 4. The file(s) are moved to the selected location.

COPY



Copy photos between cloud drives.

- 1. Select file(s) from your cloud drives.
- 2. Select the **Copy** option and then select a cloud drive to copy the selected file(s) to it.
- 3. The file(s) are copied to the selected location.

SHARE



Share photos using the supported services.

1. Select file(s) from your cloud drives.



2. Select the **Share** option and then choose one of the share options to share the selected file(s). Follow the prompts to share the file(s) with one of the supported services.

RENAME



ab Rename a photo on the source drive.

- 1. Select the file you want.
- 2. Select the Rename option (not available for local My Device files), enter a new file name and tap Update/OK.

ADD TO FAVORITES



Select file(s) to add to your list of favorite files.

- 1. Select file(s) from your cloud drives.
- 2. Select the Favorite option. The file appears with a small star icon indicating that it's a favorite
- 3. Go to the Favorites mode to see the List View and Thumbs view of all your favorite files (for more info see the Favorites section).

REMOVE FROM FAVORITES



Select file(s) to remove from your list of favorite files.

- 1. Select the favorite file(s) you want to remove from the **Favorites** view.
- 2. Select the Remove from favorites option. This option appears when selecting the file(s) with a small star indicating it as a labelled favorite file.
- 3. This will only remove the file from the **Favorites** view and will not actually delete the file. The file will remain in the source location as it did before.





Android: Videos View Tabs

Tap **Videos** on the **Home** screen. The **Videos** screen with the following view options appears.

LIST VIEW:

Tap the **List** tab on the **Videos** screen to view a list of the videos on the connected cloud drive accounts. Each file appears with the file name and thumbnail.

Note: After tapping **Videos** from the **Home** screen, the List view appears by default.

THUMBS VIEW:

Tap the **Thumbs** tab on the **Videos** screen to view thumbnails of the videos on your cloud drive accounts.



TIMELINE VIEW:

Tap the **Timeline** tab on the **Videos** screen to navigate through the videos in your cloud drive accounts sorted by years, months or days, based on the date the file was created on the cloud.

VIEWING OPTIONS:



Cloud Drive File Source:

Each file appears with a small icon indicating its cloud drive source.

• Filter by drive:

Select the **Filter by drive** menu option and then choose the options you want from the cloud drives list. Only the files on the selected drives will display on the screen. This filter will reset automatically when you leave the **Videos** view screen and return to the **Home** screen.

Sort by:

Select the **Sort by** menu option (not available on the Timeline view) and then choose to sort by file name, date or file type. The files will display sorted by file name, date or file type. This filter will reset automatically when you leave the **Video** view and return to the **Home** screen.

• Refresh Content:

Full Size View:

Tap on a video to view it in Full Size view.

2. Play Videos

This section explains how to play a video.

Tap on a video in one of the views to play it in **Full Size** view. The video begins to download for local playback. The default player will play the file. If there is no default player, a prompt appears to select a player.

- On Android: Tap on a video to download it for playback. If prompted, choose an app to play it in full size. Use playback controls to play the video. When the video ends the app returns to the previous view.
- 2. On iOS: Tap on a video to download it for playback. When the ▶ Play icon tap again to play it in full size. Use playback controls to play the video. When the video ends the app returns to the previous view.

3. Selection Mode: Select Files

Open the selection mode to select multiple files.

On Android: Long tap on one file to select that file and open the selection mode. Tap on other
files to select additional files. Each selected file appears with a check mark. The number of
selected files appears on the top of the screen. Tap 'X' to deselect the files and exit the
selection mode.



- On iOS: Tap the Select menu option to open the selection mode and select multiple files. The number of selected files appears on the top of the screen. Tap Cancel to exit the selection mode.

- 3. The file(s) are copied to the selected location.

Share videos using the supported services.

RENAME



ab Rename a video on the source cloud drive.

- 1. Select the file you want.
- 2. Select the Rename option (not available for local My Device files), enter a new file name and tap Update/OK.








BY NAME VIEW

Tap the **By Name** tab on the **Music** screen to view a list of the music sorted by file name on your cloud drive accounts. Each file appears with the file name, file type and date.

Note: After tapping Music from the Home screen, the By Name view appears by default.

BY DATE VIEW

Tap the **By Date** tab on the **Music** screen to view a list of the music sorted by date on your cloud drive accounts. Each file appears with the file name and date.



BY TYPE VIEW

Tap the **By Type** tab on the **Music** screen to view a list of the music sorted by file type on your cloud drive accounts. Each file appears with the file name and date.

 of content in the connected drives.

XIV. Settings

This section explains all functionality available for the app settings.

The Settings allow you to control the uploading of your files and offline file accessibility. To access the Settings:

- 1. Tap **Menu** located on the top bar.
- 2. Tap **Settings** to open the Settings screen.

The following Setting options appear.

1. Uploads

This section explains how to upload new local content automatically to cloud drives.

Upload new content from your mobile device to cloud drive accounts.

Tap the Menu button and then the Settings option.

The following options appear under the UPLOADS section of the settings.

UPLOAD NEW CONTENT

Tap the control to select YES and turn the option on. This allows the app to upload new content automatically. All new content added to the local device after this option is enabled will be automatically uploaded according to the upload settings.

The following settings appear when enabled:

1. Media to Upload

Check the media type check boxes to upload.

Android: Photos, videos, music and documents.

iOS: Photos, videos and music.

2. Upload Destination

Select the cloud drive as upload destination. The following options appear:

Let the app decide: YES

Tap the control to select **YES**. The app will select the upload destination.

Let the app decide: NO

Tap the control to select **NO**. Select each destination drive per content.

- **Upload Photos to**: Tap to select the upload drive for photos.
- **Upload Videos to**: Tap to select the upload drive for videos.
- **Upload Music to**: Tap to select the upload drive for music.
- **Upload Documents to**: Tap to select the upload drive for documents.

PHOTO UPLOAD SIZE

Tap a setting to select a photo size option: Original, Medium, Small



UPLOAD NEW CONTENT ONLY VIA WIFI

Tap the box to select **YES** to upload only via Wi-Fi.

If the option is disabled, when **NO** is selected, the content will be uploaded via mobile data.

UPLOAD NOW

Use this option to upload all the content that is already on your local device to the connected cloud accounts. The content types and destination cloud drives are determined based on the other upload settings that are set in the **Uploads** settings.

- 1. Tap **Upload Now** to begin the upload.
- 2. A confirmation window appears. Tap **Yes** to continue or **No** to exit.
- 3. To continue after tapping **YES**, you are prompted to set your upload settings if they are not set.
- Cancel Uploads: When any upload is in progress, the Upload Now option will become a Cancel Uploads option. Use the Cancel Uploads option to stop all current uploads

2. Offline Files

This section explains how to save files for offline view.

Option to store files that were opened in the app to a local device cache so they are accessible in the app for even when the device is offline.

- 1. Tap the **Menu** button and then the **Settings** option.
- 2. Tap **YES** on the control for the **Cache the stuff I use so I can access it offline** option so that any file that is downloaded while this setting is enabled will remain accessible and continue to appear in the app even when the mobile device has no internet connectivity.
- 3. The **Offline Cache Size** displays the offline cache size details.
- 4. Tap the **Empty cache** option to clear the app's download cache on the local device.

3. About Cloud Binder

- This section explains the information shown about Sprint Cloud Binder.
 - 1. Tap the **Menu** button and then the **Settings** option. The following information appears:
 - 2. Tap About Sprint Cloud Binder on the Settings screen.
 - Tap Terms of Service to view the Sprint terms of service.
 - Tap Open Source Licensees view the licenses for the open source software used in the development of the app.
 - Tap Rate Sprint Cloud Binder to rate the app. The store entry for Sprint Cloud Binder will
 open in the Google Play Store where you can rate the app and leave a comment.

1. Ads in Media views

Sprint Cloud Binder is provided to Sprint customers for free. The app includes ads spaced out throughout the Photos, Videos, Music, Documents, Folders, and Favorites views.

Tapping an ad in the Sprint Cloud Binder app will open the advertisement outside of the Cloud Binder app.



XVI. High Level Differences Between Operating Systems

This section lists some of the high-level differences between operating systems that affect functionality in Sprint Cloud Binder

1. Upload of Local Content

- 1. Android can upload any content on the device that is recognized as Music, Photo or Video. Documents for upload include the following file types: txt, pdf, xls, xlsx, rtf, doc, docx, epub, wps, wpd, ppt, pptx, csv, pps, ods, odt, vcf
- 2. iOS can upload pictures and videos from the Camera Roll.

2. File Downloads and Download Destinations

- 1. Android downloads content to a Sprint Cloud Binder folder in the Downloads folder.
- 2. iOS downloads Pictures and Videos to the Camera Roll.

3. Media Playback

All media playback is dependent on the local playback support on the particular device. If the device doesn't support a particular file, it will not play in Sprint Cloud Binder.

4. Background Upload of New Content

- 1. Android supports uploading new content even while app is in the background.
- 2. iOS Phone will upload new content automatically only when the app is in the foreground. Background uploads are not supported by this OS.

5. Upload/Download Notifications

- 1. Android will show an upload/download progress indicator in the notifications pane when content is uploading/downloading.
- 2. iOS shows an upload notification overlay in the app interface when content is uploading. Download progress is shown on each file.
