Seniors bound for a college should have a senior packet containing information that will help complete the necessary steps for College Applications.


Things to support the application process:

- A list of 5-10 colleges/universities that you want to apply to
- SAT/ACT Scores from your Junior Year
- Copy of your **Transcript**.
- A Calendar to help keep track of important dates.
- An **E-mail Account**: Make sure it is appropriate for College Admission Officers. Remove spam blockers.
- Social Media: Remove any pictures or wording that could be offensive if viewed by an Admissions Officer.



- A completed "Letter of Recommendation Request" form
- Identify at least **THREE** people who have agreed to write letters of Recommendation for you
- A list of Activities and Community Service hours
- A draft of your Personal Insight Questions (UC) or Essays (Private Universities) As needed


Accessing the Letter of Rec & BCAD Packet

Central Valley Promise

Central Valley Promise students must:

- Have a minimum high school GPA of 2.7 by the end of junior year including summer school (weighted or unweighted, whichever is higher). Must be verified by high school.
- On track for completion of 'A-G' requirements or a CTE pathway.
- Submit a FAFSA application by March 2 of their senior year of high school.
- Fully matriculate: complete the community college application, assessment, Student Educational Plan (SEP), and orientation by March 15th.
- Register for 15 units or more at any SCCCD college or center in Fall 2019.
- Complete five hours of community service each semester such as mentoring other students in the 6-12 grades.
- Work toward a degree or certificate as articulated in the Student Educational Plan (SEP).
