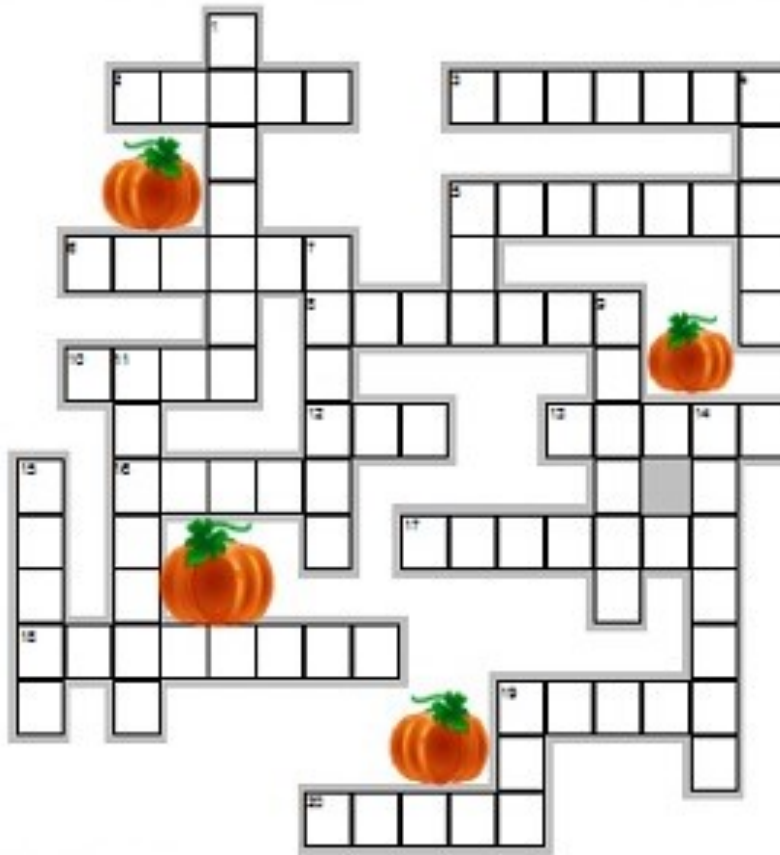

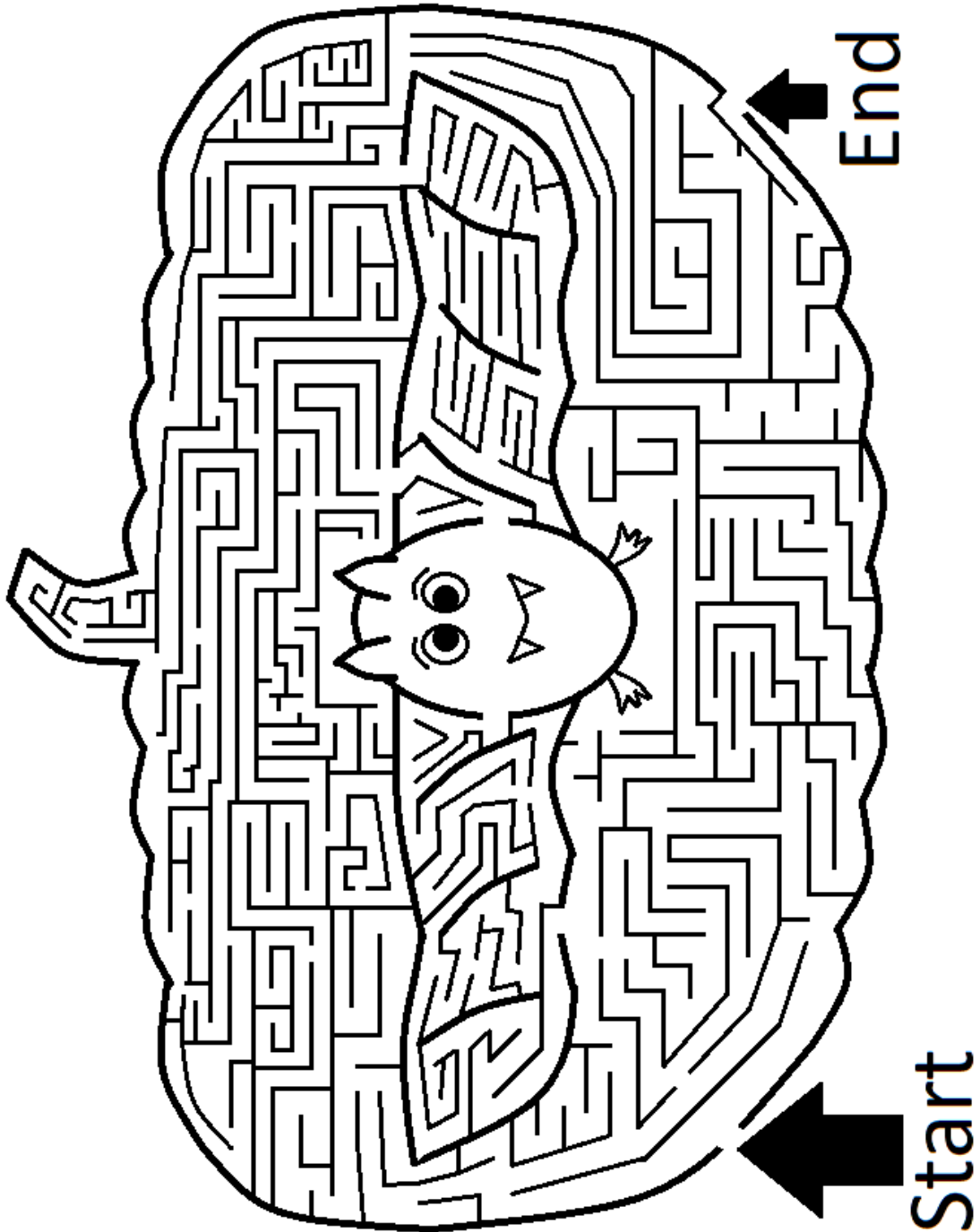

## Recipe

### Pumpkin Pie

#### Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cup of sugar
- 1 tsp. salt
- 2 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp. ground cloves
- 4 large eggs
- 1 (29oz) Libby's 100% pure pumpkin
- 2 cans (12 fl. oz. each) Carnation evaporated milk
- 2 unbaked 9-inch deep dish pie shells



#### Instructions:

- MIX sugar, salt, cinnamon, ginger, and cloves in a small bowl. Beat eggs in large bowl. Stir in pumpkin and sugar-spice mixture. Gradually stir in evaporated milk
- Pour into pie shells
- Bake in preheated 425 degree oven for 15 minutes or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Cool on wire rack for two hours. Serve immediately or refrigerate.

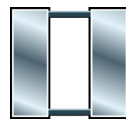
## Chief's Box
