

COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION TAX CREDIT — ANNUAL REPORT CALENDAR YEAR 2018

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Empire State Development (ESD) oversees administration of the Empire State Commercial Production Tax Credit Program. The Program is designed to increase the production of commercial filming in New York State ("NYS").

Credits of up to \$7 million per year can be allocated to encourage qualified production companies to produce commercials in NYS and help create and maintain jobs. The \$7 million per year consists of three components for companies: shooting commercials Downstate (\$3 million), shooting Upstate (\$3 million), and those demonstrating incremental "growth" in commercial production (\$1 million).

An applicant can receive a credit of 5% on qualified production expenses under the Upstate and Downstate components of the Commercial Tax Credit Program. An additional 20% credit is available under the Growth component for eligible incremental growth in production expenses from one year to the next.

Credit for Downstate (\$3 million)

The Downstate component is based on filming or recording qualified commercials within the Metropolitan Commuter Transportation District (MCTD). The MCTD includes New York City, Dutchess, Nassau, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Suffolk and Westchester counties.

To qualify, more than \$500,000 in total qualified costs attributable to the production of qualified commercials within the MCTD during the calendar year must be incurred.

The amount of credit is initially calculated as 5% of qualified costs over the \$500,000 threshold. Credits are distributed on a pro rata basis among applicants for the downstate credit.

Credit for Upstate (\$3 million)

The Upstate component is based on filming or recording of qualified commercials *outside* the MCTD but within NYS.

To qualify, more than \$100,000 in total qualified costs attributable to the production of qualified commercials outside the MCTD during the calendar year must be incurred.

The amount of the credit is initially calculated as 5% of qualified costs over the \$100,000 threshold. Credits are distributed on a pro rata basis among applicants for the Upstate credit

If unused, the \$3 million available for commercials produced upstate can be reallocated to the production companies qualifying for the growth credit.

Credit for Growth (\$1 million)

The growth component is based on year-to-year growth in a company's qualified costs, regardless of where within NYS those costs are incurred.

The first year an applicant applies for the growth component, it must demonstrate that the total of all qualified costs during the year was greater than the total of all similar costs incurred in the previous year. In subsequent years, applicants average two and ultimately three previous years' qualified costs to establish a baseline against which growth is measured. The current year costs must be greater than the baseline. The amount of the credit is initially calculated as 20% of the incremental growth in costs between the previous year and the current year.

The maximum growth credit a company can receive is \$300,000 and credits are distributed on a pro-rata basis among applicants for the growth credit.

APPLICATIONS

ESD accepts applications by April 1st each year for commercials produced the previous year. All applications received for each of the three components are reviewed for completeness and the qualified costs verified. Once the total amount of credits earned for each component of the Program has been determined, the pro rata value for each applicant is calculated and a certificate of tax credit issued.

PROGRAM ACTIVITY

The credits issued to date over the life of the Program are as follows:

- 2010 \$5.7 million in credits based on 34 applications representing 498 commercials
- 2011 \$5.6 million in credits based on 39 applications representing 408 commercials
- 2012 \$5.8 million in credits based on 36 applications representing 369 commercials
- 2013 \$5.4 million in credits based on 43 applications representing 513 commercials
- 2014 \$5.0 million in credits based on 34 applications representing 405 commercials
- 2015 \$3.87 million in credits based on 34 applications representing 423 commercials
- 2016 \$4.4 million in credits based on 35 applications representing 335 commercials
- 2017 \$3.06 million in credits based on 33 applications representing 256 commercials
- 2018 \$3.36 million in credits based on 30 applications representing 248 commercials

Beginning with tax year 2015, information is required to be disclosed about the name of the company receiving the tax credit, the amount of tax credit issued, and the credit eligible hours and wages for each commercial production company issued credits. Chart A below shows this information for companies receiving credits for commercials produced in 2018¹.

Information about whether any of the \$3 million in credits earmarked for commercials produced upstate is unused and reallocated to downstate applicants qualifying for the growth credit is also required. However, since the request for growth credits in 2018 was less than the \$1 million allocated for this purpose, there was no need to reallocate any upstate credits.

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¹ Chart A shows \$2,918,125 in credits issued to companies that produced commercials during calendar year 2018. The total credits issued for 2018 was \$3,361,279 which includes \$443,154 in carry-over credits from commercials produced during calendar year 2017.
