

# 50 PLACES TO GO FISHING WITHIN 60 MINUTES

OF ROSEBURG

LET'S GO FISHING ON SATURDAY. Not enough time? Think again – if you live in the Roseburg area, there are many places you can get to in less than an hour. Make sure you read the Oregon Sport Fishing Regulations before you go. Mileage and generalized directions are from the Douglas County Courthouse, 1036 SE Douglas.

1. AMACHER COUNTY PARK, Winchester – 6 mi., 9 min.

Salmon, steelhead

Boat ramp and some bank access on N. Umpqua River. Take I-5 N to exit 129, Winchester/Wilbur. Right at OR-99/NE Stephens, make first right after bridge.

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2. APPLE CREEK CAMPGROUND

(fly fishing only) - 44 mi., 50 min. Steelhead, trout
Primarily catch and release bank fishing. Access to N. Umpqua hiking trail. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 43.5 miles to campground on right.

3. BAKER MEMORIAL

WAYSIDE, Idleyld Park (fly fishing only) - 25 mi., 31 min.

Steelhead, trout

Popular day-use area with bank fishing. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 25 miles to wayside on right. DC

4. BEN IRVING RESERVOIR, Tenmile - 18 mi., 24 min.

Trout, crappie, bluegill, bass

Stocked rainbow trout and warmwater fishing. Take I-5 S to exit 119. Merge onto Hwy. 42, go about 11 miles. Left at Ireland Rd, go about 0.5 miles. Right at Berry Cr. Rd.

5. BOGUS CREEK CAMPGROUND

(fly fishing only) - 35 mi., 42 min. Steelhead, trout Primarily catch and release fishing. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 35 miles. Bogus Creek river access on right.

6. BOULDER FLAT CAMPGROUND, Toketee (fly fishing only) - 53 mi., 59 min.

Steelhead, trout

Primarily catch and release fishing adjacent to Boulder Creek Wilderness area. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 52.5 miles to campground on left.

7. BUNCH BAR, Elkton - 44 mi.. 52 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, bass Great bank fishing access on lower Umpqua River. Take I-5 N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin.

Left onto OR-138 W, go 24 miles. Left onto OR-38 W/Umpqua Hwy, go about 6 miles, destination on left.

8. CABLE CROSSING WAYSIDE, Idlelyd Park (fly fishing only) – 23 mi., 28 min.
Steelhead. trout

Popular fly fishing hole with good bank access. Go west on Hwy 138 for 23 miles. Wayside is on right, just one mile past Swiftwater Recreation Area. It's a steep, short driveway just before the guardrail begins.

9. CALAPOOYA CREEK (STEARNS PARK), Oakland - 16 mi., 22 mins.

Trout

Access to Calapooya Creek. Park closed in winter. Take I-5 N to exit 138. Merge onto Stearns Ln., go about 1 mile. Slight left to stay on Stearns Ln., left onto Goodman Ave.

#### 10. "CAMP WATER" AT MOTT BRIDGE,

Steamboat (fly fishing only) - 39 mi., 46 min. Steelhead, trout

Primarily catch and release with great bank fishing for summer steelhead in scenic and historic setting. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 39 miles. Turn right over Mott Bridge, park on right and hike down trail to river.

#### 11. CANYONVILLE (BEHIND SEVEN

FEATHERS CASINO), Canyonville - 26 mi., 28 min. *Steelhead, bass* 

Bank access near winter steelhead acclimation site. Take I-5 S to exit 99 N. Canyonville/Crater Lk. Left at Creekside Rd/Jeffreys Rd. Left onto Gazley Bridge Rd, go about 0.25 miles. Pull into parking area just before bridge.

## 12. CLEVELAND RAPIDS PARK, Garden Valley - 14 mi., 20 min.

Salmon, steelhead, bass, shad

Boat launch and great bank access for steelhead and salmon. Take I-5 N to exit 129, Winchester/Wilbur. Right onto OR-99 S/NE Stephens. Turn right at signal onto Del Rio Rd., go 4.5 miles. Right onto Garden Valley Rd., go about 2.5 miles. Keep left at fork then turn left onto Cleveland Rapids Rd. Go about 1 mile to boat ramp on left.

## 13. COLLIDING RIVERS BOAT RAMP, Glide - 16.5 mi., 20 min.

Salmon, steelhead

Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd. Go about 16 miles. Boat ramp on left, just before Little River Rd.

## 14. COOPER CREEK RESERVOIR, Sutherlin - 16 mi., 28 min.

Trout, bass, bluegill

Boat ramps, bank fishing and day-use park. Take I-5 N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Right on West Central Avenue. Right at Waite St., and continue on Southside Rd. Right at Cooper Cr. Rd.

#### 15. DAYS CREEK BOAT RAMP, Canyonville -

34 mi., 45 min.

Steelhead

Take I-5 S to exit 98, Canyonville/Days Cr. Left onto 1st St/Canyonville-Riddle Rd. Take 2nd right onto SE Main St. Take 2nd left onto SE 3rd St., continue onto Douglas County Hwy 1/Tiller Trail Hwy. Go about 7 miles. Turn right after crossing bridge over river.

## 16. DEER PARK (STEWART PARK), Roseburg – 0.5 mi., 3 min.

Steelhead

Bank fishing and day-use park with bike trails, playground, and ball fields. Head NW on SE Douglas Ave. Turn right onto SE Jackson St. Continue onto NE Winchester St., and left onto NE Rowe Ave. Walk bike path to mouth of Deer Cr.

## 17. DOUGLAS COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS BOAT RAMP, Roseburg - 3 mi., 6 min.

Steelhead, bass

Boat ramp, bank fishing, RV park, playground, and museum. Take I-5 S to exit 123, Fairgrounds/Umpqua Park. Left at Heritage Way / SW Portland Ave. First right onto Frear St. Boat ramp is near horse barns.

## 18. EAGLE ROCK CAMPGROUND, North Umpqua (fly fishing only) - 51 mi., 58 min.

Steelhead, trout

Bank fishing. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd. Go about 51 miles, river access on left. 🛧 🕼 🛕

#### 19. ELKTON BOAT RAMP, Elkton - 38 mi., 46 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Boat ramp and bank fishing adjacent to RV park. Take I-5
N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W. Go
about 24 miles. Left onto OR-38 W/Umpqua Hwy. Take
third left onto 2nd St., right at River Rd.

#### 20. GALESVILLE RESERVOIR, Azalea - 37 mi., 42 min.

Trout, landlocked coho, bass, bluegill
Boat ramp, playground, trails. Take I-5 S to exit 88,
Azalea/Galesville Reservoir. Left at Azalea-Glen Rd.
Continue onto Upper Cow Creek Rd. about 7.5 miles to
boat ramp on right.

#### 21. HAPPY VALLEY BOAT RAMP, Green District -

6 mi., 12 min.

Steelhead, smallmouth bass

Boat ramp and bank fishing. Take I-5 S to exit 120, Green District/Roseburg. Slight right toward OR-99S, left at OR-99S. Take first right onto E. Happy Valley Rd., right at Amber St., left onto Poteet St.

## 22. HAROLD AND SID NICHOLS PARK, Winston – 10 mi., 19 min.

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
Bass, steelhead

Boat ramp and bank access near mouth of Lookingglass Creek. Take I-5 S to exit 119. Merge onto OR-42, go 3 miles. Stay right on OR-42 and go about 0.7 miles to boat ramp on left.

#### 23. HESTNESS PARK, Roseburg - 8 mi., 16 min.

Steelhead, salmon

Boat ramp and bank access to the N. Umpqua River. Take I-5 N to exit 129, Winchester/Wilbur. Right at OR 99 S/NE Stephens St. Right at signal onto Del Rio Rd, go about 3.5 miles to park on left.



#### 24. HORSESHOE BEND CAMPGROUND,

Dry Creek Area (fly fishing only) - 48 mi., 56 min. Trout, steelhead

Raft boat launch and bank fishing. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 46 miles. Turn right at campground sign and go about 0.5 mile.

## 25. HUTCHINSON STATE PARK, Tyee - 28 mi., 34 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Bank fishing and day-use area. Take I-5 N to exit 136,
Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W, go about 15 miles.
Park is on left.

#### 26. ISLAND CREEK DAY-USE AREA, Riddle - 31 mi., 46 min.

Trout, steelhead

Bank fishing access on Cow Creek. Take I-5 S to exit 103, Tri-City/Myrtle Creek. Slight right onto Pruner Rd, continue onto Riddle Bypass Rd, go about 5 miles. Continue onto Cow Cr Rd. about 4 miles to site on left.

## 27. JAMES WOOD BOAT RAMP, Tyee - 22 mi., 35 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Boat ramp and bank fishing. Take I-5 N to exit 136,
Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W then left onto Fort
McKay Rd/Sutherlin Umpqua Rd. Go about 6 miles and

turn right onto Tyee Rd. Go about another 6 miles, boat ramp on left.

## 28. LAWSON BAR, Canyonville - 24 mi., 29 min. Steelhead, smallmouth bass Boat launch and bank fishing. No restroom. Take I-5 S to exit 102. Right at Gazley Rd, left onto Lawson Bar Rd., go about 0.5 miles to gravel bar.

## 29. LITTLE RIVER (EMILE REC SITE), Glide - 31 mi., 46 min.

**Trout** 

Bank fishing and nearby hiking trails. Take OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd. for 16 miles. Right onto Little River Rd., go about 5.5 miles, stay left. Continue on Little River Rd. about 9 miles to site on right.

## 30. MACK BROWN PARK, Umpqua - 19 mi., 38 min. Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass Wooded rural park with bank fishing. Take I-5 N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W. Left onto Fort McKay Rd/Sutherlin Umpqua Rd, go about 6 miles. Right onto Tyee Rd., go about 3.5 miles to park on left.

#### 31. MYRTLE CREEK BOAT LAUNCH, Myrtle Creek - 18 mi., 23 min.

Smallmouth bass, steelhead

Gravel bar boat launch. Take I-5 S to exit 108, Myrtle

Creek. Left onto N Main St, go about 1 mile. Right onto SW Western Ave, follow for about 0.25 mile to gravel bar.

**32.** NARROWS WAYSIDE, Idlelyd Park - 21 mi., 27 min. *Steelhead, chinook* 

Popular bank fishing site. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 21 miles to wayside on right.

33. OSPREY BOAT RAMP, Tyee - 31 mi., 46 min. Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Boat ramp and bank fishing. Take I-5 N to exit 136,
OR-138, Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W, go 10.5 miles. Left onto Tyee Rd. and go 7 miles to boat ramp on right.

#### 34. PICKETT PARK (CANYONVILLE PARK),

Canyonville - 28 mi., 35 min.

Steelhead, bass

Boat ramp and bank access, playground. Take I-5 S to exit 98 Canyonville-Riddle Rd. Left at 1st St/Canyonville-Riddle Rd. Second right onto SE Main St. Take second left onto SE 3rd St., continue onto Douglas County Hwy 1/Tiller Trail Hwy. about 1 mile. Left on Pickett Lane.

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35. PLAT I RESERVOIR, Sutherlin - 17 mi., 32 min.

Trout, bass, bluegill

Day-use area with boat ramp and bank fishing. Take I-5 N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Right onto W. Central Ave. Go about 3.3 miles, continue straight onto Nonpareil Rd. Go about 1 mile, right at Plat I Rd. and go about 1 more mile.

36. RED TOP POND, Myrtle Creek - 38 mi., 60 min. *Trout, bass* 

Pond stocked with catchable-sized trout in spring, and warm water fishing year-round. Take I-5 S to exit 108, Myrtle Creek. Left onto N. Main St. Go 0.5 miles then turn left onto Riverside Dr. (turns into South Myrtle Cr. Rd.) and go about 16 miles. Road becomes one lane here and is BLM Rd. 28-2-35.0. Drive from this point 4 miles to pond on left.

37. RIVER FORKS PARK, Roseburg - 8 mi.,18 min. Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Boat ramp and bank fishing at confluence of North and South Umpqua rivers. Family park. Head NW on SE Douglas Ave. Right onto SE Stephens, go about 1 mile. Left onto NE Garden Valley Blvd., go about 5 miles. Left onto Old Garden Valley Blvd., and go about 1.5 mile. Left onto River Forks Park Rd.

38. SAWYERS RAPIDS RV PARK, Scottsburg - 47 mi., 56 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass

Private fee boat launch and camping. Take I-5 N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W and go about 24 miles. Left onto OR-38 W/Umpqua Hwy. Go about 10 miles. Sawyers Rapids RV Park on left.

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39. SCOTTS CREEK BOAT RAMP, Scottsburg - 48 mi., 58 min.

Salmon, steelhead

Day-use park with boat launch. Take I-5 N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W and go about 24 miles. Left on OR-38 W/Umpqua Hwy. Go about 11 miles to boat ramp on left.

**40. SINGLETON PARK**, Garden Valley – 7.5 mi., 17 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Bank fishing at confluence of North and South
Umpqua rivers. Head NW on SE Douglas Ave. Right
onto SE Stephens, go about 1 mile. Left onto NE
Garden Valley Blvd., go about 4 miles. Left onto
Curry Rd for 1.7 miles, turn right onto N. Curry Road
and go about a half mile to the park on right.

41. SODA SPRINGS RESERVOIR, Toketee - 54 mi.. 60 min.

**Trout** 

Dispersed camping nearby and hiking on the N. Umpqua Trail. Take OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd. for 55 miles. Left onto Rd 4775, reservoir on left.

42. STANTON PARK, Canyonville - 26 mi., 33 min. Steelhead, smallmouth bass

Day-use park with boat ramp. Group camping available. Take I-5 S to exit 101, Riddle. Right onto Ravenswood Rd. (signs for Stanton Park/Riddle/OR-99). Right onto Stanton Park Rd, go about 1.5 miles to park on left.

43. STEWART PARK, Roseburg - 2 mi., 6 min. Steelhead, smallmouth bass

Bank access and large family park on the S. Umpqua River. Head NW on SE Douglas Ave. Left onto SE Stephens, right onto SE Washington Ave. Go about 0.4 miles. Continue onto W. Harvard Ave., go about 0.7 miles. Right onto Centennial Dr., left onto W. Stewart Park Dr., go about 0.3 miles.

44. SUSAN CREEK CAMPGROUND, Idleyld Park - 29 mi., 36 min.

Steelhead, trout

Bank fishing, raft launch, waterfalls, trail. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd. Go about 29.5 miles to campground on right.

**45.** SWIFTWATER RECREATION AREA, Idleyld Park - 23 mi., 30 min.

Salmon, steelhead

Day-use area with pavilion and hiking trails. Head east on OR-138 E/NE Diamond Lake Blvd., go about 23 miles to site on right.

**46. TEMPLIN BEACH PARK,** Roseburg, - 1 mi., 5 min. *Steelhead, smallmouth bass* 

Day-use area with boat ramp and dog park on S. Umpqua River. Head NW on SE Douglas Ave. and turn left on SE Stephens. Continue onto SE Pine St., turn right onto SE Mosher, take second left onto SE Flint, turn right and end at boat ramp.

47. TYEE RECREATION AREA, Tyee - 25 mi., 30 min. Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Bank fishing, campground, and day-use park. Take I-5
N to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin. Turn left onto OR-138
W, go about 11 miles. Turn left onto Bullock Rd., drive over bridge and turn right. Go about 0.5 miles to area on right.

48. UMPQUA LANDING BOAT RAMP, Umpqua - 16 mi., 30 min.

Salmon, steelhead, shad, smallmouth bass
Day-use park and boat ramp. Take I-5 N to exit 136,
Elkton/Sutherlin. Left onto OR-138 W, go about 0.5
miles and turn left onto Fort McKay Rd/SutherlinUmpqua Rd. Go about 6.5 miles to boat ramp parking lot on left.

50. YELLOW CREEK BOAT RAMP, Tyee - 25 mi., 31 min.

Salmon, shad, steelhead, smallmouth bass
Boat ramp and bank access. Site includes a large
parking area. Take I-5 to exit 136, Elkton/Sutherlin.
Turn left onto OR-138 W. Go about 13 miles to boat
ramp on left.


