All interested parties are advised to call Hear Now to discuss eligibility before completing an application for assistance. Not everyone will qualify for the program's assistance so making this phone call is highly recommended. Hear Now works with local hearing healthcare providers throughout the US who volunteer their time and service to test, fit and follow up on the patient and their adjustment to the hearing aids. The applicant is responsible for finding a provider in his/her area to provide the professional services through the process. There is an application processing fee of \$125 per hearing requested. When an application is approved, aids are given to the applicant at no additional cost.

The hearing aids provided are Behind the Ear models and are new. Custom hearing aids are not provided by Hear Now.
