Be prepared at your interview by thinking of answers to these below questions. If you need help with how to answer these types of questions contact WorkOne or KIC-IT (Kids In Crisis Intervention Team).

- 1. What is your greatest strength?
- 2. What is your greatest weakness?
- 3. How do you handle stress and pressure?
- 4. How do you evaluate success on the job?
- 5. Why do you want this job?
- 6. Why did you leave your last job?
- 7. Why should we hire you?
- 8. What are your goals for your future?
- 9. Tell me a little about yourself?

Tips for a successful interview!

- 1. Listen carefully to questions
- 2. Answer questions as directly as possible
- 3. Use examples of how your skills and abilities would fit into the job you are interviewing for
- 4. Be upbeat and use positive statements
- 5. Check out the company before the interview check out their website
- 6. Greet the employee with a firm handshake and make eye contact
- 7. Dress for success
- 8. Practice interviewing at WorkOne or KIC-IT
- 9. Go alone no children or friends
- 10. Make frequent eye contact
- **11.** Have confidence
- 12. Believe in yourself

Common Interview Mistakes – What NOT to do!!!

- 1. Do NOT be late
- 2. Do NOT show up unprepared
- 3. Do NOT lie
- Do NOT ask if there is any reason why you should not be hired
- 5. Do NOT bring a drink or be chewing gum do NOT bring anything that could distract you
- 6. Do NOT ask about salary, benefits and perks (save this for when they offer you the job!)
