# 100 COMPANIES AND THEIR SUBSIDIARY CORPORATIONS LISTED ACCORDING TO NET VALUE OF MILITARY PRIME CONTRACT AWARDS FISCAL YEAR 1972

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Department of Defense military prime contracts for research and development, services, construction and supplies and equipment awarded to United States contractors totaled \$33,362 million during fiscal year 1972, \$3,610 million more than in FY 1971. This increase in procurement reversed the downward trend which had been prevalent during the previous four years. However, the continued concentration of high dollar awards in the major hard goods industries, such as Aerospace, Ships and Ammunition, which are dominated by large contractors, resulted in 72.1% of the U. S. total, the same as last year, being awarded to the 100 contractors which together with their subsidiaries received the largest dollar volume of military prime contracts of \$10,000 or more. Although the dollar level of defense procurement awarded to U. S. companies in FY 1972 was 12.1% higher than in FY 1971, year to year changes in most major DoD programs as well as corporate restructuring resulting from mergers, acquisitions and divestitures also influenced the selection and rank of the top 100 DoD contractors.

The top 100 companies received \$24.1 billion in defense prime contracts during FY 1972 or 72.1% of the \$33.4 billion total awarded all U. S. companies. In FY 1971, the top 100 companies received \$21.5 billion which was also 72.1% of the overall \$29.8 billion total awarded to U. S. companies. The following table shows that the first five companies on the top 100 list received 21.3% of the total contract awards received by all U. S. companies in FY 1972. This was the same as in FY 1971.

Lockheed Aircraft Corp., the company with the largest dollar amount of defense awards, has been in the number one position for the past four years. As the largest DoD contractor in FY 1972, this company received awards totaling \$1,705 million compared with a total of \$1,510 million as the largest in FY 1971. To get on the list in FY 1972 required \$35 million in prime contract awards in contrast with \$32 million last year and \$50 million in FY 1968, the peak year of procurement activity for the DoD.

Thirteen names which did not appear on the list last year are among the companies making up the list of the top 100 DoD contractors in FY 1972. Of these, one appears in position 37, one in position 55 and the balance between positions 80 and 109.

Of 86 companies appearing on the list in both FY 1971 and FY 1972, 40 bettered their positions, 43 were in a lower position and 3 showed no change. Companies are considered as appearing on the lists in both years despite mergers, acquisitions, divestitures and name changes if a major component of a newly constituted company or the newly constituted company itself made the list as a component of a company in the top 100 in the prior year. For example, Diamond Reo Trucks, Inc., which is included in the top 100 list this year, was a subsidiary of the White Motor Corp. last year.

The dollar volume of DoD prime contracts awarded to the McDonnell Douglas Corp. increased by \$804 million from year to year. This was the largest positive dollar change occurring and moved this company up in rank from seventh position in fiscal year 1971 to second place in FY 1972. Other companies with major dollar volume increases were: the Boeing Company,

United Aircraft Corp., North American Rockwell Corp., General Electric Co. and Northrop Corp. Contract awards to the Boeing Company, which went from ninth to fifth place, increased by \$439 million while each of the other listed companies increased by more than \$200 million. In addition to McDonnell Douglas Corp. and the Boeing Company, other companies with major position changes were: Northrop Corp. which went from 34th place last year to 17th place this year; AMF, Inc., from 81st to 64th; Standard Oil of Indiana, from 100th to 70th; Gould Inc., from 72nd to 33rd; Chrysler Corp., from 33rd to 57th; Raymond Morrison Knudsen (JV), from 45th to 95th and Olin Corp., from 30th to 58th place.

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Other changes concerning companies on the FY 1972 list were: the disposal by Ling-Temco-Vought, Inc. (now called LTV Corp.), of LTV Electrosystems, Inc., LTV Ling Altec, Inc. and Braniff Airways, Inc. E Systems, Inc. (formerly LTV Electrosystems, Inc.) is included in the top 100 company list in position 53; the acquisition of Page Aircraft Maintenance, Inc. by Northrop Corp. which changed the name of Page Aircraft to Northrop Worldwide Aircraft Service, Inc.; the merger of Atlas Chemical Industries, Inc. with ICI America, Inc. and the sale by White Motor Corp. of its Diamond Reo Truck Division which now appears in 80th place as Diamond Reo Trucks, Inc.

Although the contract work of many companies on the list includes more than one procurement category, each company has been assigned in the following table to the procurement category that accounts for its largest dollar volume of defense awards. For example, International Telephone and Telegraph Corp. is a multi-industry company producing electronic and communications equipment and industrial and consumer products. For this table it is assigned to "Electronics," the procurement category accounting for its largest dollar volume of DoD contract awards. On this basis "Aircraft" companies increased by four from FY 1971 to FY 1972. while companies engaged in "Services" decreased by four.

Seven companies received prime contract awards in excess of \$1 billion each in FY 1972. Of those companies in this group, McDonnell Douglas Corp., the Boeing Company, the American Telephone and Telegraph Co. and Grumman Corp. showed the most significant changes from the previous year. McDonnell Douglas Corp. moved up from seventh place last year to second place this year, the Boeing Company moved up from ninth place last year to fifth place this year, ATT&T dropped from third place last year to sixth place this year while Grumman Corp. dropped from fourth place last year to seventh place this year. The seven companies and a brief description of their work are as follows:

Lockheed Aircraft Corp. leads the list for the fourth successive year with \$1,705 million, or 5.1% of the total. This was an increase of \$195 million in value over last year, however the company's share of total remained virtually unchanged. The aircraft contracts of this company include the C-5A Galaxy Jet Transport, the P-3 Antisubmarine Patrol Plane, the C-130 Hercules Transport and the S-3A Carrier Borne Antisubmarine aircraft. Missile work includes the Poseidon.

McDonnell Douglas Corp., in seventh place last year, jumped to second place in FY 1972 as its contract volume almost doubled. Total awards received by this company last year amounted to \$897 million or 3.0% of total while in FY 1972 contract values totaled \$1,700 million for 5.1% of total. The aircraft contracts of this company include the F-4 Phantom series, A-4 attack aircraft and F-15 fighter aircraft.

General Dynamics Corp., in second place last year fell to third place this year as its contract volume of \$1,289 million represented 3.9% of the FY 1972 total. In FY 1971, this company received \$1,489 million for 5.0% of total. This company received contracts for aircraft, ships and missiles. The aircraft contracts were largely for the F-lll series of aircraft; those for ships included new construction of submarines as well as ship maintenance and repair and alteration work, and the missile contracts involved, among others, the Redeye, Sidewinder and Standard Arm (SAM) missiles.

General Electric Co., in fifth place last year with \$1,041 million or 3.5% of total, moved up to fourth place this year on a volume of \$1,259 million for 3.8% of total. Turbojet and turbofan aircraft engines were an important part of this company's production and development effort. Aerospace activity also included the Minuteman III missile. Other substantial contracts were received for ordnance and electronics equipment and nuclear reactors.

Boeing Co. in fifth place this year received its highest ranking since FY 1956 when it was also in the number 5 position. This years contract volume for the Boeing Co. reached \$1,171 million for 3.5% of the total. Last year Boeing Co. received \$732 million which was equivalent to 2.5% of total. This company's major work this year was predominantly in missiles, aircraft and electronics. Missile programs included the Minuteman and Short Range

Attack Missile (SRAM). Aircraft programs included the production of Helicopters and electronics included work on the Airborne Warning and Control Systems (AWACS).

American Telephone and Telegraph Co. in third place last year fell to sixth position in FY 1972. In FY 1971 AT&T received defense awards totaling \$1,200 million or 4.0% of total. In FY 1972, awards to this company totaled \$1,122 million for 3.4% of total. Western Electric Co., Inc., a major subsidiary of AT&T, accounted for \$908 million or 81% of the total defense awards received by the company. In FY 1971, Western Electric had received \$977 million which was also 81% of the AT&T total. Major defense contracts were for work on the Safeguard Defense System.

Grumman Corp. dropped from fourth place in FY 1971 to seventh place in FY 1972, although its volume of awards increased slightly. In FY 1971 defense awards to Grumman totaled \$1,098 million for 3.7% of total. In FY 1972, this company's dollar volume was slightly higher (\$1,120 million), however, its share of total fell to 3.4%. Aircraft contracts received by Grumman in FY 1972 included the F-14A multi-mission fighter/interceptor, EA-6B Electronic Warfare aircraft and A-6E attack aircraft.

Procurement actions include definitive contracts, the obligated portions of letter contracts, purchase orders, job orders, task orders, delivery orders, and any other orders against existing contracts. The data do not include that part of indefinite quantity contracts that have not been translated into specific orders on business firms, nor do they include purchase commitments or pending cancellations that have not yet become mutually binding agreements between the government and the company.
