Pupil Free Day - No School on Friday

Staff will be involved in a Staff Development Day on Friday, 28 August. The pupil free day has been planned at this time to allow students from Condobolin Public School to attend the show if they wish.

For our Staff Development Day, we are expecting to have a total of seventy-one staff from across Condobolin Public School, Condobolin High School and Condobolin Family and Community Services participate in specialised training in behaviour management that promotes the care, welfare, safety and security of staff and students in educational settings. This training equips staff with behaviour management skills to safely resolve situations where students or others may present with anxious, hostile or violent behaviour.

It has been a little over two years since staff at Condobolin Public School last participated in this training. Staff that were trained previously will be able to extend their understanding in how to deal more effectively with those people affected by trauma.

Student Welfare Policy

In the past year, we have been revising our student welfare policy to ensure that it reflects the positive work being done in PBL, but also providing information around expectations and consequences. The draft document was presented at the last P&C meeting. The updated document is being sent home today to all families.




