



(See answers below)

- 1. What is the oldest continuously operating airport in the world?
- 2. What does SMF mean?
- 3. Where is the tallest air traffic control tower?
- 4. Where is the smallest airport in the world?
- 5. Why do some airport codes end in X?
- 6. What unusual amenity does Singapore's Changi Airport have?

Answers:

- 1. College Park Airport (KCGS) in the city of College Park in Maryland. Established in 1909 when Wilbur Wright arrived at the field to train two military officers in the US Army
- 2. It stands for Sacramento Metropolitan Field. In 1998 it became Sacramento International Airport, but the identifier did not change.
- 3. Thailand's New Bangkok International Airport is 434 feet high (a 40 story skyscraper).
- 4. The Island of Saba. The Juancho E. Yrausquin airport is the shortest commercial runway, just 1299 feet long. Airlines must get permission to land there.
- 5. Before the standardization of three letter codes, some airports were just short, two-letter abbreviations of their cities. To update them, Xs were simply thrown on the end, and voila! Now you have LAX and PHX.
- 6. A nature trail and butterfly garden with over 1000 butterflies.
